



Moss Stitch Baby Blanket

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 24"

Circumference: 26"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Everyday® Baby (100% Anti-pilling Acrylic; 113gm/308 yds)

- #DNE 101-09 Yellow (A) - 1 ball
- #DNE 101-14 Aqua (B) - 2 balls

Needles: US Size 6 (4 mm) 24" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge.

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

22 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Moss St

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Garter Stitch

Knit every row.

Moss Stitch (over an odd number of sts)

Row 1 (WS): * K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (RS): * P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 3: * P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 4: * K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Rep Rows 1-4 for pattern.

BLANKET

With A, cast on 121 sts.

Work 3 rows Garter Stitch, beginning and ending with a WS rnd.

With B, work 4 rows Garter Stitch.

With A, work 4 rows Garter Stitch. Break A.

With B, knit 1 RS row.

Work in Moss Stitch until piece measures 23", ending with a WS row.

With A, work 4 rows Garter Stitch.

With B, work 4 rows Garter Stitch.

With A, work 4 rows Garter Stitch.

Bind off.

Edging

With RS facing, using A, pick up and knit along side edge of blanket at the rate of 1 st for every 2 rows in Garter Stitch section and 2 sts for every 3 rows in Moss Stitch section.

Work 3 rows Garter Stitch, beginning and ending with a WS rnd.

With B, work 4 rows Garter Stitch.

With A, work 4 rows Garter Stitch.

Bind off.

Repeat on other side.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.

Abbreviations

k knit

p purl

rep repeat

st(s) stitch(es)
