

Blue Ridge Crochet Cap

SIZES

Women's (Men's) Shown in Men's

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 20 (22)"

Length: 101/2"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Muir Woods (100% acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 170yds/155m)

• #1074-08 Creek – 1 ball

Hook: US Size J-10 (6 mm) crochet hook *or size*

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

14.5 hdc x 8 rows = 4" in hdc through the back loop only.

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Hat is worked side to side, then seamed. Fold brim up to desired length.

HAT

Ch 37, leaving an 8" tail at the beginning of your chain.

Setup Row: Hdc in 3rd ch from hk, hdc across – 36 hdc.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 1, working in back loop only across, sl st in next 5 sts, ch 2 (counts as first hdc throughout, in same st as last sl st), hdc in each hdc across, turn – 32 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 2, working in back loop only across, hdc in next 28 hdc, turn – 28 hdc.

Row 3: Ch 1, working in back loop only across, sl st in next 5 sts, ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn – 24 hdc.

Row 4: Ch 2, working in back loop only across, hdc in each st across, including sl sts and skipped hdc from Rows 1-3, turn – 36 hdc.

Repeat Rows 1-4, 9 (10) more times.

With RS together, hold beginning edge and last row together and work 1 row of sl st across to seam back of hat closed. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Use tail from beginning tail to sew closed top of Hat. Fasten off.
Weave in ends.

sl st slip stitch
