



Burled Cocoon

Level: Intermediate

SIZES

Small/Medium (Large/X-Large)
Shown in Small/Medium Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 40 (46)''

Length: 34 (36)''

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Muir Woods* (100% acrylic;
3.5oz/100g, 170yds/155m)

- #1074-06 Redwood – 7 (9) balls

Hook: US Size J-10 (6 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

16 sts (or 4 shells) x 6 rows = 4'' in pattern

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Bpdc (back post double crochet): Yo, insert hook from back to front to back around the post of the st and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

Fpdc (front post double crochet): Yo, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of the st and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

COCOON

Ch 164 (188).

Row 1: 2 dc in 3rd from hook (skipped ch count as turning ch), ch 2, sc in next ch, *sk 2 ch, 2 dc in next ch, ch 2, sc in next ch; rep from * across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, (2 dc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-2 sp across, dc in turning ch, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 34 (36)''.
Fasten off.

Fold piece in half with beginning chain & final edges together. Sew a 7½'' seam on either side, sewing along the ends of the rows, leaving an opening at the fold as an armhole.

Sleeve Edging

Join yarn at the end of the seam around one of the 2 smaller openings, work 2 rounds of single crochet. Fasten off.

Body Edging

Join yarn at the end of the seam around the larger opening.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc evenly around, working an even number of sc, sl st in 1st sc to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a stitch), *fpdc around next sc, bpdc around next sc; rep from * around, sl st in 1st dc to join.

Rnds 3-4: Ch 2, *fpdc around next dc, bpdc around next dc; rep from * around, sl st in 1st dc to join.
Fasten off.
