



# Mountain Flora Beanie

Level: Easy

## SIZES

Women's

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 10" excluding pom pom

**Head Circumference:** 17" at band, unstretched

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Muir Woods** (100% acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 170yds/155m)

- #1074-05 Mount Tam – 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, removable stitch marker, pom pom maker

## GAUGE

13 sts x 11 rows = 4" in patt

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## STITCH GUIDE

**Puff Stitch:** Yo, insert hook in indicated st, yo, pull up a loop, yo, insert hook into same st, yo, and draw up a loop (four loops on hk), yo and draw through all loops on hook, ch 1 to complete.

**Bobble Stitch:** \*Yo, insert hook, yo and pull through 2 loops on your hook\*, rep from \* until there are 6 loops on your hook, pull through all six.

## PATTERN NOTES

The band on the beanie is made first and joined together, then worked in the round.

## BEANIE

Ch 9.

**Row 1:** Sc blo in 2nd ch from hk and each ch across, turn - 8 sc.

Rep Row 1 until piece measures approx. 17", relaxed.

Join the two short edges of the band together by sc across, being careful not to twist piece.

*Note: You will now begin working in the round for the remainder of the beanie.*

**Setup Rnd:** Ch 1, sl st in same spot, work 66 sc evenly around hat band. Place removable marker in last sc to mark end of rnd and begin working in a spiral. Move marker up each rnd to keep your place.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc in blo of each sc around.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 4 (counts as tr here and throughout), tr in each hdc around.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 2, hdc in blo of each tr around.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, \*puff stitch in next hdc, sc in next hdc; rep from \* to end of rnd.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 2, hdc in blo of each st around.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 5 hdc, bobble st in next hdc; rep from \* to end of rnd.

**Rnd 7:** Ch 2, hdc in blo of each st around.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 5, tr in blo of each st around.

**Rnd 9:** Ch 2, hdc in blo of each st around.

**Rnd 10:** Ch 1, \*puff stitch in next hdc, sc in next hdc; rep from \* to end of rnd.

**Rnd 11:** Ch 2, hdc in blo of each st around.

**Rnd 12:** Ch 4, tr2tog to end of rnd – 33 tr sts.

# Mountain Flora Beanie

Fasten off, leaving a tail approx. 10-12" long.

## FINISHING

Using a tapestry needle, weave the tail through the 33 stitches and pull to close the top of the beanie.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Use pom pom maker to make a pom pom and sew to top of beanie.

<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>hdc</b>	half double crochet
<b>hk</b>	hook
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>sl st</b>	slip stitch
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>tr</b>	treble crochet
<b>tr2tog</b>	treble crochet the next 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>yo</b>	yarn over
