



SIZES

Women's (Men's)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 21¼ (23¾)"

Height: 9 (10½)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Muir Woods (100% acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 170yds/155m)

• #1074-09 Sierra – 1 (2) balls

Needles: US Size 9 (5.5 mm) 16" circular needle and double-pointed needles, US size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, 2½" pom pom maker (optional)

GAUGE

16 sts x 20 rows = 4" in stockinette on larger needles

Save time, check your gauge.

HAT

With smaller circular needle, cast on 85 (95) sts. Place marker (pm) and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1-12: *K3, p2; rep from * around.

Change to larger circular needle and knit every rnd until hat measures 7 (8)".

Shape Crown

Note: Change to double-pointed needles when stitches no longer fit comfortably around circular needle.

Rnd 1 – Woman's Size Only: Knit 1 rnd, decreasing 1 st – 84 sts.

Rnd 1 – Men's Size Only: Knit 1 rnd, increasing 1 st – 96 sts.

Rnd 2: *Knit 12 (14), k2tog, pm; rep from * 5 more times – 78 (90) sts.

Rnd 3: Knit.

Rnd 4: *Knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, slip marker; rep from * 5 more times – 6 sts dec'd.

Repeat Rnds 3-4, 6 (8) more times – 36 sts.

Repeat Rnd 4, 4 more times – 12 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail and thread through remaining sts, pull snug to close top of hat. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

(Optional) Make pom pom following instructions on pom pom maker and tie to top of hat.

Abbreviations

dec'd decreased

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

p purl

pm place marker
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
st(s) stitch(es)
