



Wanderlust Headband

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 18" unstretched

Height: 6½"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Muir Woods (100% acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 170yds/155m)

- #1074-13 Coho – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, 2 – 7/8" buttons

GAUGE

19 sts x 24 rows = 4" in pattern unstretched

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

w&t (wrap and turn): Wyib, slip next st purl-wise, bring yarn to front, slip st back to left-hand needle purl-wise, bring yarn to back, turn work.

3-Stitch Buttonhole (worked over 4 sts)

Slip 1 pwise wyif, bring yarn to back.

*Sl 1 pwise, pass 1st slipped st over 2nd slipped stitch; rep from * 2 more times – 3 sts bound off.

Place last st back on left needle and turn work. Returning to beginning of buttonhole, cast on 4 sts as follows: *insert right needle between 1st and 2nd sts on left needle, draw up a loop and place it on left needle; rep from * 3 more times, turn.

Bring yarn to back, slip 1st st on left needle to right needle, pass last cast-on st over slipped stitch.

PATTERN NOTES

As you work Rows 10-13, when you reach a stitch that had previously been worked as part of a w&t, pick up the wrap with your right needle and place it on the left needle, work it together with the next stitch, working it as a k2tog, ssk, p2tog, etc as needed so that the wrap is hidden on the WS of the fabric.

When working short rows on Rows 10 & 12, the "gap" is the wider space between stitches left when you work your w&t.

HEADBAND

Cast on 87 sts.

Rows 1 & 3 (WS): *P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 2 (RS): *K3, p3; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 4 (RS): Kfb, k2, *p3, k3; rep from * to last 6 sts, p3, k1, kfb, k1 – 89 sts.

Rows 5 & 7: P2, *k1, p1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 6: K1, *k3, p3; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 8: Kfb, *k3, p3; rep from * to last 4 sts, k3, kfb – 91 sts.

Row 9: *P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 10: K5, work 3-Stitch Buttonhole, [k2, work 3-Stitch Buttonhole] twice, [work in patt to last 23 sts, w&t] twice, [work to 4 sts before the gap, w&t] 8 times, work to end hiding wraps to WS of work.

Row 11: *P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1, hiding wraps to WS of work.

Row 12: K1, k2tog, work 53 sts in patt, w&t, work 21 sts in patt, w&t, [work to 2 sts past gap (hiding wrap to WS), w&t] 8 times, work in patt to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 89 sts.

Row 13: P2, *k1, p1; rep from * to last st, p1, hiding wraps to WS of work.

Row 14: K1, *k3, p3; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 15: P2, *k1, p1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 16: K1, k2tog, k1, *p3, k3; rep from * to last 7 sts, p3, k1, ssk, k1 – 87 sts.

Row 17: *P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 18: *K3, p3; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Bind off in pattern.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Sew 2 buttons onto headband opposite buttonholes.

Abbreviations

k	knit
kfb	knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)
k2tog	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
p	purl
p2tog	purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
patt	pattern
pwise	purlwise
rep	repeat(ing)
RS	right side
sl	slip
ssk	slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
W&T	wrap next st and turn
WS	wrong side
wyib	with yarn in back
wyif	with yarn in front



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
