

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 8"

Circumference: 40"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Muir Woods (100% acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 170yds/155m)

• #1074-02 Sorrel - 2 balls

Hook: US Size J-10 (6 mm) crochet hook or size

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

5 daisies = 3" in pattern

Save time, check your gauge.

COWL

Ch 31.

Row 1: [Insert hook in next ch and draw up a loop] 5 times, yo and pull through all 6 loops on hook, ch 1 (daisy made), *insert hook into center of last daisy and pull up a loop, insert hook into last leg of daisy and pull up a loop, insert hook into last ch used for the previous daisy and pull up a loop, [insert hook into next ch and draw up a loops] twice, yo and pull through all 6 loops on hook, ch 1 (daisy made); rep from * 11 more times, dc in last ch, turn – 13 daisies.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), work 2 hdc in the final ch 1 of each daisy across (center of daisy), hdc in turning chain, turn – 28 hdc.

Row 3: Ch 3, [insert hook into next ch and draw up a loop] twice, [insert hook into next hdc and draw up a loop] 3 times, yo and pull through all 6 loops on hook, ch 1 (daisy made), *insert hook into center of last daisy and pull up a loop, insert hook into last leg of daisy and pull up a loop, insert hook into last hdc used for the previous daisy and pull up a loop, [insert hook into next hdc and draw up a loops] twice, yo and pull through all 6 loops on hook, ch 1 (daisy made); rep from * 11 more times, dc in turning chain, turn – 13 daisies.

Repeat Rows 2-3 until cowl measures 40", ending with Row 2.

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

FINISHING

Sew beginning edge to final row to form a loop, being careful not to twist cowl.

Weave in ends.

dc double crochethdc half double crochet

rep repeat(ing)

sk skip

yo yarn over
