



# Offset Stripe Pullover

Level: Intermediate

## SIZES

Women's Small (Medium, Large, Extra Large, 2X)

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust:** 38 (42, 46, 50, 54)" (oversized fit)

**Length:** 22 (22, 23, 24, 25)"

## MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Everyday® Soft Worsted* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 113 g/203 yds)

- #ED100-02 Cream – 3 (3, 3, 3, 3) balls (A)
- #ED100-12 Black – 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) balls (B)
- #ED100-07 Really Red – 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) balls (C)

**Needles:** US Size 8 (5 mm) 24" circular needles or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch marker

## GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## STRIPE PATTERN

\*6 rows B, 6 rows A, 6 rows C, 6 rows B, 6 rows A; rep from \*.

## STITCH GUIDE

### K1, P1 Rib

**Row 1 (RS):** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 2:** \*P1, k1; rep from \* to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 for pattern.

## FRONT AND BACK

### Center Panel (make 2)

With A, cast on 38 (40, 43, 46, 51) sts. Work in garter st (knit every row) for  $\frac{3}{4}$ ". Continue in A in St st for 3". Work stripe patt in St st a total of 3 times, then continue in A until piece measures 21½ (21½, 22½, 23½, 24½)" from beg. Work in garter st for  $\frac{1}{2}$ " more. Bind off.

### Right Panel (make 2)

*Note: Sleeve is cast on and worked as one piece with panel. Take care that garter trim for side vent is on same side of panel as sleeve for each one.*

With A, cast on 26 (28, 31, 33, 36) sts. Work in garter st for  $\frac{3}{4}$ ", ending on a WS row.

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2:** K3, purl to end.

Rep last 2 rows for 3".

With A, work in St st for 4".

Beg stripe patt, working in St st on all sts, until piece measures 14 (14, 14½, 15, 15½)", ending at side edge.

At beg of next row, cast on 14 (14, 16, 16, 18) sts for sleeve, then finish as for center panel, working stripe patt a total of 3 times as before.

### Left Panel (make 2)

*Note: Sleeve is cast on and worked as one piece with panel. Take care that garter trim for side vent is on same side of panel as sleeve for each one.*

With A, cast on 26 (28, 31, 33, 36) sts. Work in garter st for  $\frac{3}{4}$ ", ending on a WS row.

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2:** Purl to last 3 sts, k3.

Rep last 2 rows for 3".

With A, work in St st for 4".

Beg stripe patt, working in St st on all sts, until piece measures 14 (14, 14½, 15, 15½)", ending at side edge.

At beg of next row, cast on 14 (14, 16, 16, 18) sts for sleeve, then finish as for center panel, working stripe patt a total of 3 times as before.

## FINISHING

Sew center panel between side panels on front and back. Sew shoulder seams, leaving center 10 (10, 10, 11, 12)" open for neck.

## Cuff

With RS facing and A, pick up and knit 75 (75, 77, 81, 85) sts along cuff edge of sleeve. Work in K1, P1 Rib for 3". Bind off in patt. Rep on opposite side.

Sew side and sleeve seams leaving 3" at bottom of panel open for side vent . Weave in ends. Block.

## Abbreviations

**beg** begin(ning)

**k** knit

**p** purl

**patt** pattern

**rep** repeat(ing)

**RS** right side

**st(s)** stitch(es)

**St st** Stockinette stitch: Knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.

**WS** wrong side
