

Pinwheel Blanket

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 32" Width: 32"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Parfait* (100% polyester; 300g/574 yds)

#1044-10 Blue (A) – 1 ball

Premier® Yarns *Parfait Flavors* (100% polyester; 250g/487 yds)

#1045-02 Blueberry Pie (B) – 1 ball

Hook: US Size 9 (5.5mm) circular needles 24" long

or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, small amount smooth

yarn in color to match A.

GAUGE

12 sts x 20 rows = 4" in Garter Stitch Each block measures 8" square. Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

It can be challenging to sew using a chenille yarn. Use a smooth yarn in a color that matches yarn A to sew your blocks together.

We've shown this as a 32" square baby blanket, but one ball of each color gives you plenty of yarn to make this a 48" square throw. Just make 36 Pinwheel blocks and arrange them in 6 rows of 6 blocks.

Pinwheel Block

With A, cast on 2 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Kfb, k1 - 3 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Kfb, knit to end – 1 st increased.

Rows 3-32: Rep Row 2 – 34 sts when Row 32 is complete.

Change to B.

Row 33 (RS): K2tog, knit to end – 1 st decreased.

Rows 34-64: Rep Row 33 – 2 sts when Row 64 is complete.

Bind off.

THROW

Make 16 Pinwheel Blocks.

Arrange blocks as shown in diagram. Sew together, using smooth yarn.

FINISHING

Edging

With RS facing, using A, pick up and knit 80 sts along one side of blanket at the rate of 20 sts per block.

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Bind off loosely.

Repeat on remaining 3 sides of blanket.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

k knit

k2tog knit 2 stitches together – 1 st decreased

kfb knit in front and back of same stitch – 1 st increased

RS Right Side rep repeat st(s) stitch(es) WS Wrong Side
