

## Cupcake and Ice Cream Cone

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

## Cupcake

Height: 6"

## Ice Cream Cone

Height: 91⁄2"

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Parfait ${ }^{\circledR}$ Chunky Pom Pom (85\% Polyester, 15\% Polyamide; 3.5 oz/100g, 109 yds/100m)

- MC: 2107-03 Party Pink - 1 ball

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Parfait ${ }^{\circledR}$ Chunky (100\%
Polyester; 3.5 oz/100g, 131 yds/120m)

- CC1 (Cupcake): 1150-02 Yellow - 1 ball
- CC2 (Ice Cream Cone): 1150-16 Toffee - 1 ball

Needle: 2-US Size 9 ( 5.5 mm ) 16" circulars or set of dpns and 2-US Size 10.5 ( 6.5 mm ) circulars or set of dpns and straight or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stuffing

## GAUGE

11 sts $\times 16$ rnds $=4 "$ in St st
Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Knit front and back increases.
- Knit 2 together and purl 2 together decreases.
- Small circumference knitting in the round.
- Joining live stitches by knitting together.
- Passing a stitch over a stitch and off the


## needle.

- Seaming.


## PATTERN NOTES

These sweet and snuggly treats are worked from the bottom up in the round starting with the cake or cone. The frill for the icing and ice cream starts flat and then is joined with the cake or cone and worked in the round, leaving only a small seam to sew. Two $16^{\prime \prime}$ circular needles or double point needles are suggested for working these small pieces in the round, but magic loop or traveling loop can also be used. If using double point needles, you will need a pair of straight needles in the larger size to work the frill.

## CUPCAKE

## Base

With smaller needles and CC1, cast on 4 sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, careful not to twist sts.
Rnd 1: [Kfb] 4 times - 4 sts inc'd, 8 sts total.
Even Rnds 2-6: Knit.
Rnd 3: $[\mathrm{Kfb}] 8$ times -8 sts inc'd, 16 sts total.
Rnd 5: *Kfb, k1; rep from * to end -8 sts inc'd, 24 sts total.
Rnd 7: ${ }^{*} \mathrm{Kfb}, \mathrm{k} 2$; rep from * to end -8 sts inc'd, 32 sts total.
Rnd 8: Purl.

## Cake

Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnd 1 until Cake meas $3^{\prime \prime}$ from Rnd 8 of Base. Leave sts on needles and cut yarn.

## project continued

Frill
With larger circular or straight needles and MC, cast on 128 sts.
Row 1 (RS): *K2, lift $1^{\text {st }}$ st worked over $2^{\text {nd }}$ st and off working needle; rep from * to end - 64 sts dec'd, 64 sts rem.
Row 2 (WS): *P2tog; rep from * to end - 32 sts dec'd,
32 sts rem.
Do not cut yarn.

## Join Frill and Cake

Hold both the Cake and Frill together with both RS facing and Frill on top (WS of Frill will be touching RS of Cake) and with larger needle and cont with MC, knit $1^{\text {st }}$ st of Cake tog with $1^{\text {st }}$ st of Frill. Cont in this manner until all sts of the Cake have been knit tog and joined with the Frill, pm and join to work in the rnd.

## Icing

Cont with MC, work even in St st until Icing meas 2" from Join.

Shape Icing
Rnd 1: *K2, k2tog; rep from * to end - 8 sts dec'd, 24 sts rem.
Even Rnds 2 and 4: Knit.
Rnd 3: *K1, k2tog; rep from * to end - 8 sts dec'd, 16 sts rem.
Stuff Cupcake.
Rnd 5: *K2tog; rep from * to end, 8 sts dec'd, 8 sts rem.
Rnd 6: Rep Rnd 5-4 sts rem.
If needed, add additional stuffing. Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw
through remaining sts.

## ICE CREAM CONE

## Cone

With smaller needles and CC2, cast on 4 sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, careful not to twist sts.
Rnds 1-2: Knit.
Rnd 3: ${ }^{*} \mathrm{Kfb}$; rep from * to end -4 sts inc'd, 8 sts total.
Rnds 4-5: Knit.
Rnd 6: *K1, kfb, pm; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, kfb 4 sts inc'd, 12 sts total.
Rnds 7-8: *K1, p1, k1, sm; rep from * to end.
Rnd 9: Knit.
Rnd 10: *Knit to 1 st bef m, kfb, sm; rep from * to end - 4 sts inc'd, 16 sts total.

Rnds 11-12: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rnd 13: Knit.
Rnd 14: Rep Rnd 10-20 sts total.
Rnds 15-16: *[K1, p1] twice, k1, sm; rep from * to end.
Rnd 17: Knit.
Rnd 18: Rep Rnd 10-24 sts total.
Rnds 19-20: Rep Rnds 11-12.
Rnd 21: Knit.
Rnd 22: Rep Rnd 10-28 sts total.
Rnds 23-24: *[K1, p1] 3 times, k1, sm; rep from * to end.
Rnd 25: Knit.
Rnd 26: Rep Rnd 10-32 sts total.
Rnds 27-28: Rep Rnds 11-12.
Rnds 29-30: Knit.
Leave sts on needles and cut yarn.

Work and join Frill as for the Cupcake.

## Ice Cream

Cont with MC, work even in St st until Ice Cream meas 3" from Join.

## Shape Ice Cream

Rnd 1: *K2, k2tog; rep from * to end - 8 sts dec'd, 24 sts rem.
Even Rnds 2 and 4: Knit.
Rnd 3: *K1, k2tog; rep from * to end - 8 sts dec'd, 16 sts rem.
Stuff Ice Cream Cone.
Rnd 5: *K2tog; rep from * to end, 8 sts dec'd, 8 sts rem.
Rnd 6: Rep Rnd 5-4 sts rem.
If needed, add additional stuffing. Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

## FINISHING

Sew open ends of Frill together. Weave in ends.
