# **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 48" Height: 48"

#### **MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns** *Parfait® Chunky Pom Pom* (85% Polyester, 15% Polyamide; 3.5 oz/100g, 109 yds/100m)

- MC: 2107-02 Neon Nights 6 balls
- CC1: 2107-01 Let's Glow 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Parfait® Chunky (100% Polyester; 3.5 oz/100g, 131 yds/120m)

- CC2: 1150-53 Lagoon— 1 ball
- CC3: 1150-34 Turquoise 1 ball
- CC4: 1150-44 Seaglass 1 ball
- CC5: 1150-12 Sunshine 1 ball
- CC6: 1150-15 Tangerine 1 ball
- CC7: 1150-11 Mango 1 ball
- CC8: 1150-13 Bright Pink 1 ball
- CC9: 1150-09 Very Berry 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size L-11 (8 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

# **GAUGE**

9 sc x 9 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

# Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chains and single crochet stitches.
- Working single crochet into the sides of rows.

# **PATTERN NOTES**

This oversized log cabin blanket is worked modularly from the center out.

# **BLANKET**

#### Center

With CC1, ch 13.

**Row 1:** Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across. turn – 12 sc.

**Rows 2-12:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

# Section 1

**Row 1:** With CC2, work 12 sc along final row of Center.

**Rows 2-6:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

# Section 2

Rotate work 90 degrees clockwise.

**Row 1:** With CC2, work 6 sc along side of Section 1 and 12 sc along side of Center – 18 sc.

**Rows 2-6:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

# Section 3

Rotate work 90 degrees clockwise.

**Row 1:** With MC, work 6 sc along side of Section 2 and 12 sc along side of Center – 18 sc.

**Rows 2-6:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

#### Section 4

Rotate work 90 degrees clockwise.

**Row 1:** With MC, work 6 sc along side of Section 3, 12 sc along side of Center, and 6 sc along side of Section 1-24 sc.

**Rows 2-6:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

# Section 5

Rotate work 90 degrees clockwise.

**Row 1:** With CC3, work 6 sc along side of Section 4, 12 sc along Section 1, and 6 sc along side of Section 2-24 sc.

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Fasten off.

# Section 6

Rotate work 90 degrees clockwise.

**Row 1:** With CC3, work 6 sc along side of Section 5 and 18 sc along Section 2, and 6 sc along side of Section 3 – 30 sc.

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Fasten off.

## Section 7

Rotate work 90 degrees clockwise.

**Row 1:** With MC, work 6 sc along side of Section 6, 18 sc along Section 3, and 6 sc along side of Section 4 - 30 sc.

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Fasten off.

# **Section 8**

Rotate work 90 degrees clockwise.

**Row 1:** With MC, work 6 sc along side of Section 7, 24 sc along Section 4, and 6 sc along side of Section 5 – 36 sc.

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Fasten off.

# Sections 9-32

Continue as established, using diagram as a guide for

color and placement.

# **FINISHING**

Weave in ends and block.

**cc** contrasting color

ch chain
MC main color
sc single crochet
