

Parallelogram Cowl

SIZES

Kids (Adult) Shown in Adult Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 28 (32)"

Height: 11 (15)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Parfait® Chunky (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 131yds/120m)

• 1150-53 Lagoon – 1 (2) balls

Needle: US Size 11 (8 mm) and US Size 10½

(6.5 mm) 16" and 24" needles and US Size 11

(8 mm) dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

10 sts x 14 rnds = 4" in Parallelogram Check with larger needle

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Knitting in the round
- Knit and purl stitches

STITCH GUIDE

1X1 Rib (even number of sts)
Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

Parallelogram Check (multiple of 10 sts)

Rnd 1: *K5, p5; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: *K4, p5, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: *K3, p5, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: *K2, p5, k3; rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: *K1, p5, k4; rep from * to end.

Rnd 6: *P5, k5; rep from *to end.

Rep Rnds 1-6 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

Cowl is worked from the bottom up in the round.

COWL

With smaller 24" circ, cast on 70 (80) sts, pm and join for working in the rnd careful not to twist sts. Work even in **1x1 Rib** until piece meas 2". Switch to larger 24" circ and work even in **Parallelogram Check** until piece meas 9 (13)" from cast-on edge. Switch to smaller 24" circ and work even in **1x1 Rib** until piece meas 11 (15)" from cast-on edge. Loosely bind off all sts in rib.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

circ circulark knit

meas measures

p purl
patt pattern
pm place marker
rem remain(ing)
rep repeat(ing)
