



Fireside Stockings

SIZES

Small (Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Height: 17 (21)" (with cuff unfolded)

Heel Width: 6 (10)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Parfait® Chunky (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 131 yds/120 m)

- MC1: 1150-13 Bright Pink – 1 ball
- MC2: 1150-12 Sunshine – 1 ball
- MC3: 1150-25 Azure – 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Little Bunny® (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 109 yds/100 m)

- CC1: 2079-01 – 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Parfait® XL (100% Polyester; 7 oz/200g, 87 yds/80 m)

- MC4: 2050-21 Hibiscus – 1 ball
- MC5: 2050-17 Seaglass – 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Parfait® Sprinkles (100% Polyester; 7 oz/200g, 87 yds/80 m)

- MC6: 2097-09 Fruit Punch – 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Bunny® (100% Polyester; 7 oz/200g, 87 yds/80 m)

- CC2: 1096-01 White – 1 ball

Hook: US Size L-11 (8 mm) & US Size P-Q (15 mm) crochet hook *or sizes needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch marker

GAUGE

8 hdc x 7 rnds = 4" with MC1 and 8 mm hook

5 hdc x 4 rnds = 4" with MC4 or MC6 and 15 mm hook

Save time, check your gauge.

Stitches/techniques used in this pattern:

- Crocheting in the round.
- Slip stitch, single, and half double crochet stitches.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

PATTERN NOTES

This stocking is worked in a spiral from the toe upward to the cuff. Do not join at the end of rounds. Use a removable stitch marker to mark the first stitch of the round and move the marker up with each subsequent round. The heel is shaped in short rows and then rejoined to work in the round. Ribbing is added at the end by working additional chains and attaching each row to the top of the round with slip stitches.

Stockings are shown in MC1, 2, & 3 with CC1 using 8 mm hook; MC4, 5, & 6 with CC2 using 11 mm hook.

STOCKING

Begin with MC and **Magic Ring.**

Toe

Rnd 1: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), work 6 hdc in ring. Place removable marker on first st of rnd and move up as you go.

Rnd 2: 2 hdc in each hdc around – 12 hdc.

Rnd 3: * 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next hdc; rep from * around – 18 hdc.

Rnd 4: * 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 2 hdc; rep from * around – 24 hdc.

Rnds 5-9: Hdc in each hdc around – 24 hdc.

Shape Heel

Note: Heel shaping is worked in rows and then continued in the rnd for the remainder of the stocking.

Row 1: Sc in next 2 sts, sl st in next st, turn leaving remaining sts unworked.

Row 2: Sk the 1st sl st, sl st in the next st, sc in next 2 sts, sl st in next st, turn leaving remaining sts unworked.

Row 3: Sk the 1st sl st, sl st in the next st, sc in next 3 sts, sl st in next st, turn leaving remaining sts unworked.

Row 4: Sk the 1st sl st, sl st in the next st, sc in next 4 sts, sl st in next st, turn leaving remaining sts unworked.

Row 5: Sk the 1st sl st, sl st in the next st, sc in next 5 sts, sl st in next st.

Note: You will now begin to work in the rnd again. Remove original stitch marker and place marker in next unworked st after the st just worked to mark the new beginning of the rnd.

Leg

Rnd 1: Hdc in each st around – 20 hdc.

Rnds 2-12: Hdc in each hdc around – 20 hdc. Do not fasten off.

Cuff

Switch to CC.

Row 1: Ch 10, turn and sc in 2nd ch from hook and

each ch across – 9 sc.

Row 2: Sl st in next 2 sts, ch 1, turn, sc blo in each st across – 9 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn and sc in each st across – 9 sc.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 continuing to attach each row to the top of the stocking with sl sts until you've reached the beginning of the round – 20 rows. Holding both edges of the ribbing together, sl st down the short side of the ribbing or seam together with tapestry needle if preferred.

Fasten off.

Hanging Loop

Using the photo as a guide, fold ribbing over the Leg and reattach yarn on top right edge of stocking directly above the heel, ch 11 and sl st into same sp yarn was attached to form loop.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
