

#### **SIZES**

1 (2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12) years Shown in Size 8 years with approx. 4" positive ease.

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Chest: 20 (22½, 24, 26½, 28, 29¾, 31¼)"
Length: 13¼ (15½, 17¼, 18¾, 20½, 21¼, 22¾)"
(not including hood)

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Parfait® Chunky (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 131yds/120m)
• 1150-24 Pale Gray 2 (2, 3, 3, 4, 4, 5) balls
Needle: US Size 11 (8 mm) straight needles, plus additional needle, US Size 10½ (6.5 mm) straight needles and/or 40" circular needle or 2 - 24" circular needles or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

10 sts x 14 rows = 4" in St st with larger needle **Save time, check your gauge.** 

#### STITCH GUIDE

1x1 Rib Even (even number of sts)
Row 1: \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end.
Rep Row 1 for patt.

**1x1 Rib Odd** (odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): \*K1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1. Row 2 (WS): P1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end. Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This Hoodie is worked from the bottom up in pieces and seamed. The hood is picked up and worked from the neckline and then the front bands are worked flat, in one piece on a long circular needle.

#### HOODIE

#### **Back**

With smaller needles cast on 26 (30, 32, 36, 38, 40, 42) sts. Work even in **1x1 Rib Even** until piece meas 2¾". Switch to larger needles and work even in St st, until piece meas 13¼ (15½, 17¼, 18¾, 20½, 21¼, 22¾)" from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts.

### Right Front

With smaller needles cast on 12 (13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18) sts. Work even in **1x1 Rib Even or Odd** (depending on the cast-on number for your size) until piece meas 2¾". Switch to larger needles and work even in St st, until piece meas 11½ (13¾, 15½, 17¼, 18¼, 18¾, 20½)" from cast-on edge. End having just worked a WS row.

#### **Neck Shaping**

**Row 1 (RS):** Bind off 2 (1, 2, 2, 1, 2, 2, 2) sts, work even in patt to end.

Row 2 (WS): Work even in est patt.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, work even in patt

to end — 1 st dec'd.

**Next Row:** Work even in patt.

Rep last 2 rows once more. – 1 st dec'd, 8 (10,

10, 12, 12, 13, 14) sts rem.

Level: Easy

# Snuggle Hoodie

project continued

Work 0 (0, 0, 0, 2, 2, 2) rows even in patt, bind off all sts.

#### **Left Front**

With smaller needles cast on 12 (13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18) sts. Work even in **1x1 Rib Even or Odd** (depending on the cast-on number for your size) until piece meas  $2\frac{3}{1}$ ". Switch to larger needles and work even in St st, until piece meas  $11\frac{1}{2}$  ( $13\frac{3}{4}$ ,  $15\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $17\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $18\frac{3}{4}$ ,  $20\frac{1}{2}$ )" from cast-on edge. End having just worked a RS row.

## **Neck Shaping**

**Row 1 (WS):** Bind off 2 (1, 2, 2, 1, 2, 2, 2) sts, work even in patt to end.

**Dec Row (RS):** Work even in patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - 1 st dec'd.

**Next Row:** Work even in patt.

Rep last 2 rows once more. – 1 st dec'd, 8 (10, 10, 12, 12, 13, 14) sts rem.

Work 0 (0, 0, 0, 2, 2, 2) rows even in patt, bind off all sts.

# Sleeves (Make 2)

With smaller needles cast on 18 (18, 20, 20, 20, 20, 20) sts. Work even in **1x1 Rib Even** until piece meas 2¼". Switch to larger needles work 2 rows even in St st.

Inc Row (RS): K1, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 - 2 sts inc'd.

**All other rows:** Work even in patt.

Rep Inc Row every 4<sup>th</sup> row 3 (4, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8) more times and then every RS row 1 (1, 5, 5, 3, 3, 3) time(s) — 8 (10, 16, 18, 18, 20, 22) sts inc'd, 28 (30, 38, 40, 40, 42, 44) sts total.

Work even until Sleeve meas 8½ (9¼, 10¼, 12, 13¼, 14¼, 14¾)" from cast-on edge, or to desired length, bind off all sts.

#### **FINISHING**

Wash and block Fronts, Back and Sleeves. Sew shoulder seams, place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Seam the Fronts and Back and Sleeves.

#### Hood

With RS facing and larger needles, pick up and knit 24 (24, 26, 26, 30, 30, 30) sts around neck opening. **Next Row (WS):** P12 (12, 13, 13, 15, 15, 15), pm, p to end.

Inc Row (RS): K to 2 sts bef m, kfb, k1, sm, k1, kfb, knit to end — 2 sts inc'd.

**All other rows:** Work even in patt.

Rep Inc Row every RS row once more and then every  $4^{th}$  row 2 times — 6 sts inc'd, 32 (32, 34, 34, 38, 38) sts total.

Work even in patt until Hood meas 5% (5, 6%, 7, 7%, 8, 9%)" from neck opening.

**Dec Row 1 (RS):** K to 3 sts bef m, ssk, k1, sm, k1, k2tog, knit to end — 2 sts dec'd.

All other rows: Work even in patt.

Work 3 rows even in patt, then rep Dec Row 1 once more -2 sts dec'd.

Dec Row 2 (RS): K to 5 sts bef m, [ssk] twice, k1, sm, k1, [k2tog] twice, knit to end — 4 sts dec'd.

All other rows: Work even in patt.

Work 1 row even and then rep Dec Row 2 once more – 4 sts dec'd, 20 (20, 22, 22, 26, 26, 26) sts rem. Fold Hood RS tog and finish with three-needle bind off. Or alternately, bind off all sts and then seam top of Hood.

#### **Front Band**

With RS facing and smaller circular needle, pick up and knit 113 (123, 139, 153, 161, 167, 181) sts along edge of Fronts and Hood. Work 1 WS row even in 1x1 Rib Odd.

Work 3 rows even, loosely bind off all sts in rib.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
