### Holiday Cheer Throw

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Width: 46" Height: 41½"

#### MATERIALS

Premier<sup>®</sup> Yarns *Parfait<sup>®</sup> XL Shimmer* (94% Polyester, 6% Metallized Polyester; 7oz/200g, 87yds/80m)

- MC: 2112-01 White Shimmer 3 balls
- CC1: 2112-07 Emerald Shimmer 2 balls
- CC2: 2112-09 Burgundy Shimmer 2 balls

**Hook:** US Size N/P-15 (10mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

6 sts x 3½ rows = 4" in double crochet **Save time, check your gauge.** 

#### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and double crochet stitches.
- Changing colors.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This blanket is worked flat from the bottom up in one piece. Cut yarn after each color change. To save time in finishing, weave in the ends as you go.

#### BLANKET

With MC, Ch 78.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook (ch 3 counts as dc here and throughout), dc in next 3 chs, \* 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 5 chs \*\*, sk 2 chs, dc in next 5 chs; rep from \* across the row ending at \*\*, turn -78 sts.

By Premier® Yarns Design Team

**Row 2:** Ch 3, sk 1st and 2nd st, dc in next 4 sts, \* 3 dc in next st, dc in next 5 sts \*\*, sk 2 sts, dc in next 5 sts; rep from \* across the row ending at \*\* (last stitch will land 1 st bef beg ch-3 below), turn.

Rows 3-4: With CC1, rep Row 2. Rows 5-6: With MC, rep Row 2. Rows 7-8: With CC2, rep Row 2. Rows 9-10: With MC, rep Row 2. Rows 11-12: With CC1, rep Row 2. Rows 13-14: With MC, rep Row 2. Rows 15-16: With CC2, rep Row 2. Rows 17-18: With MC, rep Row 2. Rows 19-20: With CC1, rep Row 2. Rows 21-22: With MC, rep Row 2. Rows 23-24: With CC2, rep Row 2. Rows 25-26: With MC, rep Row 2. Rows 29-30: With MC, rep Row 2. Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends. Gently wash and block to finished measurements.
