

Phoebe Poncho

By Premier Yarns Design Team Level: Intermediate



SIZE

2-4 yrs (6-8) yrs

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Neck circumference: 16 (18 ½)"

Length: 13 (15)"

Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll™ (100% acrylic; 140 gm/ 245 yds)

1047-21 Peaches and Cream – 2 balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6mm) circular needles 16, 24 and 32" long *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: 4 buttons, 7/8" diameter

Gauge

14 sts x 22 rows = 4" in Stockinette Stitch Save time; check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

This poncho is knit in one piece from the top down. Start with the shortest circular needle, then switch to progressively longer needles as the number of stitches grows and the work begins to feel crowded.

PONCHO

On 16" circular, cast on 56 (64) sts; pm and join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: Purl.

Rnds 3-6: Rep Rnds 1 and 2, 2 more times.

Rnd 7: * K7 (8), pm; rep from * to end – 8 markers placed.

Rnd 8: * K1, m1, knit to 1 st before marker, m1, k1; rep from * to end – 16 sts increased.

Rnds 9-13: Knit.

Rep rnds 8-13, 8 (10) more times - 200 (240) sts.

Next rnd: Purl.

Next rnd – Buttonhole Rnd: * Yo, k2tog, knit to marker, remove marker, knit to marker, sl marker; rep from * to end – 4 buttonholes made.

Next rnd: Purl.

Next rnd: Knit. Next rnd: Purl.

Bind off.

Weave in ends. Fasten off.

Sew 2 buttons back to back cufflink style. Fasten one button through each pair of buttonholes, forming "sleeves" as shown in photo.

Abbreviations

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together

m1 make 1

pm place marker on needle

rep repeat
rnd(s) round(s)
sl slip
st(s) stitch(es)
yo yarn over
