

Pixelated Pullover

Level: Intermediate

SIZES

Women's Small (Medium, Large, Extra Large, 2X)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 35½ (40, 44, 48, 52)" Length: 22 (22, 23, 23½, 24½)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Everyday® Soft Worsted (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 113 g/203 yds)

- #ED100-33 Violet 2 (2, 2, 3, 3) balls (A)
- #ED100-12 Black 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) balls (B)
- #ED100-28 Mustard 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) balls (C)
- #ED-100-23 Mist 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) balls (D)

Needles: US Size 8 (5 mm) 24" and 32" circular needles and set of 5 DPNs *or size needed to obtain aquae*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holders

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Slip Stitch (multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: With B, *k1, sl 1, k2; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: With C, *k3, sl 1; rep from * around.

Rnd 3: With D, rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 4: With B, rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 5: With A, rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 6: With D, rep Rnd 2.

Rna 6: With D, rep Rna 2

Rnd 7: With C, rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 8: With A, rep Rnd 2.

Rep Rnds 1-8 for patt.

K2, P2 Rib

Row 1: *K2, p2; rep from * around. Rep Row 1 for pattern.

BODY

With shorter circular needle and A, cast on 160 (180, 196, 216, 232) sts. Pm and join, being careful not to twist the sts. Work in K2, P2 Rib over first 80 (90, 98, 108, 116) sts, place a second marker to mark opposite side "seam", work in K2, P2 Rib to end. Continue to work in K2, P2 rib until piece measures 3". Work in St st until piece measures 10 (10, 10½, 10½, 11)" from beg. **Work Rnds 1-8 in Slip Stitch. Work with B in St st for 7 rnds. Rep Rnds 1-8 of Slip Stitch. Work 5 rnds of St st with D. Place 4 (4, 4, 5, 5) sts each side of each marker on hold for underarms. Set aside – 8 (8, 8, 10, 10) sts on hold for each underarm; 144 (164, 180, 196, 212) sts for body.

SLEEVES

With double point needles and A, cast on 36 (36, 36, 40, 40) sts. Pm and join, being careful not to twist the sts. Work in K2, P2 rib for 3". **Increase Rnd:** K1, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 2 sts increased.

Next 4 rnds: Knit.

Rep last 5 rnds 9 (9, 11, 11, 13) more times—56 (56, 60, 64, 68) sts. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures $12\frac{1}{2}$ ($12\frac{1}{2}$, 13, 13, $13\frac{1}{2}$)", work in color pattern as for body from **, placing 4 (4, 4, 5, 5) sts each side of marker on hold for underarm – 8 (8, 8, 10, 10) sts on hold for underarm; 48 (48, 52, 54, 58) sts for sleeve.

YOKE

Note: Change to shorter needle and double point needles when work no longer comfortably fits on longer circular needle.

With longer circular needle and D, join sleeves and body as follows: hold first sleeve against body, with underarm sts together, knit across 48 (48, 52, 54, 58) sleeve sts then 72 (82, 90, 98, 106) body sts to opposite underarm, hold second sleeve in place, knit across remaining 48 (48, 52, 54, 58) sleeve sts, knit remaining 72 (82, 90, 98, 106) sts for body – 240 (260, 284, 304, 328) sts. Work in D for 2 (2, 2½, 2½, 3)", dec 0 (0, 4, 4, 3) sts on last rnd – 240 (260, 280, 300, 325) sts.

Decrease rnd: *K3, k2tog; rep from * around – 192 (208, 224, 240, 260) sts.

Work in slip st patt for 2½ (2½, 2½, 3, 3)". Change to D.

Size Small Medium, Large, Extra Large Only

Decrease rnd: *K2, k2tog; rep from * around – 144 (156, 168, 180) sts.

Size 2X Only

Decrease rnd: K1, (k2tog, k2) 28 times, (k2tog, k1) 11 times, (k2tog, k2) 28 times, k2tog – 192 sts.

All Sizes

Work in D for 7 rnds. Work Rnds 1-8 of patt.

Decrease rnd: *K1, k2tog; rep from * around – 96

(104, 112, 120, 128) sts.

Work in D until yoke measures 8 (8, 8½, 9, 9½)", dec 0 (2, 1, 0, 2) sts on last rnd – 96 (102, 111, 120, 126) sts.

Decrease rnd: *K1, k2tog; rep from * around – 64 (68, 74, 80, 84) sts.

Work in K2, P2 rib for 1", decreasing 0 (0, 2, 0, 0) sts on first rnd – 64 (68, 72, 76, 84) sts.

FINISHING

Join underarms using Kitchener stitch. Weave in ends. Block.

Abbreviations

beg begin(ning)

k knit

k2tog knit two stitches together (1 st dec'd)

p purl
patt pattern
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s)
RS right side

sl slip

st(s) stitch(es)

St st Stockinette stitch: Knit every round.
