

Ribbed Pocket Scarf & Hat

**SIZES** 

**SCARF** 

Toddler (Little Kid, Big Kid)

HAT

Toddler (Little Kid, Big Kid)

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS** 

**SCARF** 

Length: 48 (52, 56)" Width: 10¾"

НАТ

Circumference: 16 (18¼, 20½)"

Height: 8 (8½, 9)"

**MATERIALS** 

Premier® Yarns Pixie Dust™ Brights (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 251yds/230m)

• 2096-14 Fairy Pink – 4 balls

**Needle:** US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular needle and set of dpns, US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

**GAUGE** 

14 sts x 22 rows = 4" in St st with larger needle Save time, check your gauge.

**STITCH GUIDE** 

**2X2 Rib Rnd** (multiple of 4 sts) **Rnd 1:** \* K2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

**2X2 Rib Flat** (multiple of 4+2 sts)

**Row 1 (RS):** \*K2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Row 2 (WS):

Rep Row 1 for patt.

### **PATTERN NOTES**

The Hat is worked in the round from the bottom up. The scarf is worked flat from end to end, once complete, the ends are folded up and sewn down to create the pockets.

HAT

**Brim** 

With smaller needles, cast on 56 (64, 72) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, careful not to twist sts.

Work even in **2x2 Rib Rnd** until piece meas 1" from cast-on edge.

Switch to larger needles.

Work even in **2x2 Rib Rnd** until piece meas 6¼ (6¾, 7¼)" from cast-on edge.

## **Crown Shaping**

Note: Switch to dpns when there are no longer enough sts to work comfortably on circular needle.

**Rnd 1:** [K2, p2, k2, p2tog] 7 (8, 9) times – 7 (8, 9) sts dec'd.

**Rnds 2, 4, 6:** Work sts as they appear, k the knits and p the purls.

**Rnd 3:** [K2, p2, k1, k2tog] 7 (8, 9) times – 7 (8, 9) sts dec'd.

**Rnd 5:** [K2, p2, k2tog] 7 (8, 9) times – 7 (8, 9) sts dec'd.

**Rnd 7:** [K2, p1, p2tog] 7 (8, 9) times – 7 (8, 9) sts dec'd.

**Rnd 8:** [K2, p2tog] 7 (8, 9) times – 7 (8, 9) sts dec'd.

**Rnd 9:** [K1, k2tog] 7 (8, 9) times – 7 (8, 9) sts dec'd.

**Rnd 10:** [K2tog] 7 (8, 9) times – 7 (8, 9) sts dec'd, 7 (8, 9) sts rem.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

### **SCARF**

With larger needle, cast on 40 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in 2x2 Rib Flat to last st, k1. Row 2 (WS): K1, work in 2x2 Rib Flat to last st, k1. Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 10 (11, 12)" from cast-on edge.

Work in Garter St until piece meas 43 (46½, 50)" from cast-on edge.

Cast on 1 st at the end of the next 2 rows – 40 sts total.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in 2x2 Rib Flat to last st, k1. Row 2 (WS): K1, work in 2x2 Rib Flat to last st, k1. Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 10 (11, 12)" from cast-on rows. Loosely bind off all sts in rib.

### **FINISHING**

Fold the ends of the Scarf (with the extra stitches) together and seam the edges, forming the pockets. Weave in ends. Block to Finished Measurements, if desired.

dec('d) decrease(d)

**dpn(s)** double point needle(s)

**Garter st** Knit every row.

**k** knit

**k2tog** knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

m markermeas measuresp purl

**p2tog** purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

patt pattern
pm place marker
rem remain(ing)
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
st(s) stitch(es)

**St st** Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
