

## SIZE

One Size.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

## Length: $971 /$ " $^{\prime \prime}$

Width: $133 / 4$ "

## MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Poppy ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (80\% Acrylic, 20\%
Wool; $5.29 \mathrm{oz} / 150 \mathrm{~g}, 98 \mathrm{yds} / 90 \mathrm{~m}$ )

- 2128-04 Ginger Root - 3 balls

Hook: US Size M/N-13 ( 9 mm ) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

7 hdc $\times 6$ rows $=4$ "
Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chains and half double crochet stitches.
- Increasing and decreasing.


## PATTERN NOTES

Scarf is worked sideways from tip to tip. In the first half, one stitch is increased every three rows until the maximum width is reached. In the second half, one stitch is decreased every three rows until two stitches remain.

## SCARF

## First Half

Row 1: Ch 3 (first 2 chs act as hdc), hdc in third ch from hook, turn - 2 hdc.
Rows 2-3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc in next hdc, turn -2 hdc.
Row 4: Ch 2, 2 hdc in next hdc, turn -3 hdc.
Rows 5-6: Ch 2, hdc in next 2 hdc, turn - 3 hdc. Row 7: Ch 2, hdc in same hdc, hdc in each hdc
to end, turn - 4 hdc.
Rows 8-9: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to end, turn 4 hdc.
Row 10: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to last hdc, 2 hdc in last hdc, turn - 5 hdc.
Rows 11-12: Ch 2, hdc in next 2 hdc, turn - 5 hdc.
Rows 13-72: Rep Rows 7-12, 10 more times 25 hdc.

## Second Half

Row 1: Ch 2, hdc2tog over next 2 hdc, hdc in each hdc to end, turn -24 hdc rem.
Rows 2-3: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to end, turn 24 hdc.
Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to last 2, hdc2tog, turn -23 hdc rem.
Rows 5-6: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to end, turn 23 hdc.
Rows 7-68: Rep Rows 1-6, 10 more times, then rep Row 1, 1 more time - 2 hdc rem.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends and block to finished measurements.

hdc2tog half double crochet 2 stitches together (1 st decreased)
