



## One Row Throw

Level: Easy

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

42" x 42"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Premier Basix™** (100% Acrylic, 7oz/200g, 359yds/328m)

- A: #1115-27 Denim – 2 skeins
- B: #1115-26 Azure – 2 skeins
- C: #1115-25 Slate – 2 skeins
- D: #1115-23 Light Blue – 2 skeins

**Needle:** US Size 10 (6 mm) 32" circular needle  
or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

14 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Broken Garter Pattern

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### STITCH GUIDE

**Broken Garter Pattern** (*multiple of 6 sts + 3*)

**Every Row:** \*K3, p3; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

### PATTERN NOTES

To avoid an excess of ends to weave in during finishing, do not cut yarn when switching to next color. Carry the yarn along the side by dropping the color not in use and bringing up new color behind the strand of the color just worked.

### THROW

With A, cast on 147 sts.

Work in **Broken Garter Pattern** throughout, working stripes as follows:

[Work 2 rows with A; work 2 rows with B] – 24 times (96 rows total).

[Work 2 rows with C; work 2 rows with B] – 24 times (96 rows total).

[Work 2 rows with D; work 2 rows with C] – 24 times (96 rows total).

Bind off in patt with C.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
