

# Pretty in Pink Hat

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Sole Length: 31/4"

# **MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns** *D.I.Y. Gradient Yarn* (100% An - pilling Acrylic; 40g/72 yds per skein; 200g/360 yds total)

#1046-01 Pink - 1 box

**Hook:** US Size F-5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook *or size* 

needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, pom pom maker

#### GAUGE

16 sc x 16 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

# **PATTERN NOTES**

Hat is worked in the round from the bottom up with darkest to lightest color. When changing colors, draw new color through last loop of last st of round.

# HAT

Using darkest color, ch 51.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, join with sl st in 1st sc - 50 sts.

**Rnds 2-3:** Ch 2 (does not count as st), \*fpdc around each of the next 2 sc, bpdc around each of the next 3 sc; rep from \* around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2. Drop current color, join next color.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 2 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in same st, sk next st, \* 2 dc in next st, sk next st; rep from \* around, join with sl st in sp between the 1st ch-2 and 1st dc.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 2, dc in sp between ch 2 and dc, 2 dc in space between each 2-dc set around, join with sl st in sp between first ch 2 and dc. Drop current color, join next color.

Rnds 6-7: Rep Rnd 5. Drop current color, join next color.

Rnds 8-9: Rep Rnd 5. Drop current color, join next color.

Rnds 10-12: Rep Rnd 5. Fasten off, leaving an 18" tail.

Using tail, sew top of hat.

Following instructions provided by manufacturer of pom pom maker, using all five colors held together, make two 3" poms and sew to each corner.
