

Coen Shawl

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 16" Length: 60"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Puzzle® Cotton (57% acrylic, 43% cotton; 7oz/200g, 349yds/320m)

• 2021-01 Fog Bank – 2 balls **Hook:** US Size J-10 (6 mm) *or size needed to*

obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

12 dc x 9 rows = 4" Rows 1-9 in pattern **Save time, check your gauge.**

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

• Chain, single, double and half double crochet stitches.

PATTERN NOTES

Place stitch markers in tops of ch-3 turning chains for ease in identifying placement of last stitch of each row.

SHAWL

Ch 52.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 50 dc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, working in BLO, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each

st across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, sk 1 st, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next st, *ch 2, sk 2 sts, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next st; rep from * across to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk 1 st, sc in last st, turn.

Row 6: Ch 3, sk next ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, *ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp; rep from * across to last ch-2 sp, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in last st, turn.

Repeat Rows 5-6 until wrap is 58" long. Do not fasten off.

Edge

Row 1: Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn. Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn. Row 3: Ch 1, working in the BLO, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in each st across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fringe

Cut 120 strands of yarn 20" long. Holding 3 strands of yarn together, fold strands in half and use crochet hk to pull through fold through the edge of the piece, pass ends through the folded loop, and pull ends to tighten. Space 20 groups of fringe evenly along each end of wrap. Trim fringe.

Weave in ends.
