

Tassel Wrap

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 21" Length: 60"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Puzzle® Cotton* (57% acrylic, 43% cotton; 7oz/200g, 349yds/320m)

• 2021-03 Sunrise - 3 skeins

Hook: US Size J-10 (6 mm) or size needed to

obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, 4½"long x 3+" wide piece of cardboard (for making tassels)

GAUGE

12 sts x 8½ rows = 4" in pattern Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and treble crochet stitches.
- Cluster stitch.
- Making tassels.

STITCH GUIDE

Cl (cluster): [Yo, insert hook in indicated st, yo and draw up a loop, yo draw through 2 loops] three times, yo, draw through 4 loops on hook.

WRAP

Ch 181.

Row 1: Sc in 2^{nd} ch from hook, tr in next ch, *sc in next ch, tr in next ch; rep from * across, turn – 180 sts.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1 (not a st), *sc in next st, tr in

next st; rep from * across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), ***CL** in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st; rep from * across, ending with dc in last st, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, *sc in next st, tr in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across, ending with tr in last st, turn. Rows 7-10: Ch 1, *sc in next st, tr in next st; rep

from * across, turn.

Rows 11-40: Rep Rows 5-10 five times.

Rows 41-42: Rep Rows 5-6.

Rows 43-45: Ch 1, * sc in next st, tr in next st;

rep from * across, turn.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Tassels (make 4)

Cut a 48" length of yarn and thread it on tapestry needle, set aside.

Wrap yarn around cardboard 25 times. Insert threaded needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard.

Trim tassel ends evenly.

Thread tassel with length of yarn and hang on each corner.
