



## Woven Rib Shlanket

### SIZE

One Size

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 64" (not including fringe)

**Width:** 37¼"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Puzzle® Cotton** (57% Acrylic, 43% Cotton; 7 oz/200 g, 349 yds/320 m)

- 2021-08 Vista – 5 balls

**Needles:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) 24" or longer circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, crochet hook (optional, for applying fringe)

### GAUGE

14 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Pattern

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Slipped stitches, with yarn in front.
- Adding fringe.

### PATTERN NOTES

This Shlanket (Shawl/Blanket) is worked flat, end to end. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches. This is the perfect multi-purpose piece for adding some extra color and warmth: use as a blanket, shawl, wrap, or scarf!

### SHLANKET

Cast on 130 sts, work 2 rows even in Garter st.

**Row 1 (RS):** K4, \*sl 2 wyif, k2; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 2 (WS):** K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece measures 63½" from cast-on edge or to desired length.

Work 2 rows even in Garter st, loosely bind off all sts.

### Finishing

#### Fringe

Cut 144 - 14" lengths of yarn. Holding 2 lengths together as one, fold in half forming a loop on one end. Insert crochet hook into st on cast-on edge of Shlanket from back to front pull the looped end of fringe partially through the edge. Pass the loose ends through the loop being sure to keep ends even. Pull taut. Place each group of fringe approximately 1" apart.

Repeat for other end of Shlanket.

Weave in ends.

### Abbreviations

<b>Garter st</b>	Knit every row.
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>wyif</b>	with yarn in front
