

Button Stitch Throw

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 45" Width: 36"

Premier® Yarns *Puzzle®* (100% Acrylic; 7 oz/ 200 g, 328 yds/ 300 m)

• 1050-48 Citrus – 4 balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) 36" circular needle

or size needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle

GAUGE

15 sts x 18 rows = 4" in Button Stitch Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Slip stitches with yarn in front or back.
- Working flat on a circular needle.

PATTERN NOTES

This Throw is worked flat from end to end. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches. All stitches are slipped purlwise.

STITCH GUIDE

Button Stitch (multiple of 10 sts + 25)

Rows 1, 3, 9 and 11 (RS): K8, purl to last 8 sts, k8.

Rows 2, 4, 10 and 12 (WS): Knit.

Rows 5 and 7: K8, p2, *k5, sl 5 wyib; rep from *

to last 15 sts, k5, p2, k8.

Rows 6 and 8: K10, *p5, sl 5 wyif; rep from *

to last 15 sts, p5, k10.

Rows 13 and 15: K8, p2, *sl 5 wyib, k5; rep from * to last 15 sts, sl 5 wyib, p2, k8.

Rows 14 and 16: K10, *sl 5 wyif, p5; rep from * to last 15 sts, sl 5 wyif, k10.
Rep Rows 1-16 for patt.

THROW

Cast on 135 sts.

Knit 16 rows.

Work even in **Button Stitch** until piece measures 41½", end having just worked any of these Rows: 1-4 or 9-12.

Knit 16 rows.

Loosely bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

k knitpatt patternp purl

rep repeat(ing)
RS right side
sl slip

st(s) stitch(es)

wyib with yarn in back wyif with yarn in front

WS wrong side
