

Basket Rib Throw

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 36" Length: 42"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Puzzle®* (100% Acrylic; 7 oz/200 g, 328 yards/300 m)

• 1050-43 Horseshoes – 3 balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) 36" circular needle

or size needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle

GAUGE

13 sts x 17 rows = 4" in pattern stitch Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

This Throw is worked flat from end to end, a circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches. This stitch pattern is reversible, so either side looks great!

THROW

Cast on 138 sts.

Main Body

Row 1 (WS): K7, *p4, k2; rep from * to last 5 sts, k5.

Row 2 (RS): K5, *p2, k4 rep from * to last 7 sts, p2, k5.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Row 5: K5, p3, *k2, p4; rep from * to last 10 sts, k2, p3, k5.

Row 6: K8, *p2, k4; rep from * to last 10 sts, p2, k8.

Rows 7 and 8: Rep Rows 5 and 6.

Rep Rows 1-8 for patt.

Work even in patt until Throw meas 42" from cast-on edge, end with a Row 4. Loosely bind off all sts in patt.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wash and block to finished measurements if desired.

k knit
meas
p purl
patt pattern
rep repeat
RS right side
st(s) stitch(es)
WS wrong side
