

Cubes

SIZES

Small (Medium, Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 3 ¾ (6, 8)" **Width:** 3 ¾ (6, 8)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Puzzle™ (100% Acrylic; 7oz/200g 328yds/300m)

• #1050-24 Catan – 1 (1, 1) ball **Needle:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) double pointed needles (set of 5) or size needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle, scissors, tape

measure, foam core

GAUGE

16 sts x 22 rows = 4" in St st **Save time, check your gauge.**

PATTERN NOTES

This pattern is written for the smallest size, with larger sizes in parentheses. If only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

The cubes are made by sewing 6 squares together. The cubes are stuffed with foam before closing completely. It's a great idea to start each square with a different colored section of the ball to enhance the colorchanging effect of the yarn.

CUBE

Square (Make 6)

Cast on 40 (64, 80) sts. Distribute sts so that 10 (16, 20) sts are each on 4 dpns. Pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Decrease Sequence

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: *Ssk, k to last 2 sts on dpn, k2tog; rep

from * 3 times more—8 sts dec'd.

Rep Rnds 1-2- 3 (6, 8) times more. 8 sts rem- 2 sts per dpn. Remove marker. Cut yarn, leaving an 8" tail. Thread tapestry ndl with tail and draw through rem sts. Pull tight and fasten securely to WS.

FINISHING

Sew the sides of the toy to form a cube, leaving one end open. With RS facing out, stuff the cube with foam core. Sew the final end shut. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

dec(d) decrease(d)

dpn double pointed needle

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

ndl needle
pm place marker
rem remain
rep repeat(ing)
rnd round

ssk slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st

dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es)

st st stockinette stitch

WS wrong side
