



Dakota Throw

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 42"

Width: 36"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Puzzle® (100% Acrylic;
7oz/200g, 328yds/300m)

- 1050-32 Dodgeball – 4 balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) 32" circular needle
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

15 sts x 18 rows = 4" in Swirling Pattern

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Swirling Pattern (multiple of 16+1 sts)

Rows 1, 5, 9, 13, 17, 21, 25 and 29 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Rows 3, 7, 11 and 15: [K1, yo] 3 times, *[ssk] twice, s2kp, [k2tog] twice, yo, [k1, yo] 5 times; rep from * end last rep with [yo, k1] 3 times.

Rows 19, 23, 27 and 31: [K2tog] 3 times, *[yo, k1] 5 times, yo, [ssk] twice**, s2kp, [k2tog] twice; rep from * end last rep at ** with 2 sts rem, ssk.

Rep Rows 1-32 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This throw is worked flat from end to end in one piece, a circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches.

THROW

Cast on 147 sts.

Edging

Row 1 (RS): P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS): K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rows 1-2, until piece meas 2½" from cast-on edge.

Main Body

Row 1 (RS): P1, [k1, p1] 4 times, work **Swirling Pattern** (beg with Row 1) to last 9 sts, p1, [k1, p1] 4 times.

Row 2 (WS): K1, [p1, k1] 4 times, work **Swirling Pattern** to last 9 sts, k1, [p1, k1] 4 times.
Cont in est'd patt until piece meas 39½" from cast-on edge or to desired length minus 2½", end having just worked a WS row.

Edging

Row 1 (RS): P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS): K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rows 1-2, until piece meas 42" from cast-on edge, loosely bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends.
