## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 42"
Width: 36"

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Puzzle ${ }^{\circledR}$ (100\% Acrylic;
7oz/200g, 328yds/300m)

- 1050-32 Dodgeball - 4 balls

Needle: US Size 10 ( 6 mm ) 32" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

15 sts $\times 18$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in Swirling Pattern Save time, check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

Swirling Pattern (multiple of $16+1$ sts)
Rows 1, 5, 9, 13, 17, 21, 25 and 29 (RS): Knit.
Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.
Rows 3, 7, 11 and 15: [K1, yo] 3 times, *[ssk] twice, s2kp, [k2tog] twice, yo, [k1, yo] 5 times; rep from * end last rep with [yo, k1] 3 times.
Rows 19, 23, 27 and 31: [K2tog] 3 times, *[yo, k1] 5 times, yo, [ssk] twice**, s2kp, [k2tog] twice; rep from * end last rep at ** with 2 sts rem, ssk.
Rep Rows 1-32 for patt.

## PATTERN NOTES

This throw is worked flat from end to end in one piece, a circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches.

## THROW

Cast on 147 sts.

## Edging

Row 1 (RS): P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.
Row 2 (WS): K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rows 1-2, until piece meas $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from caston edge.

## Main Body

Row 1 (RS): P1, [k1, p1] 4 times, work Swirling Pattern (beg with Row 1) to last 9 sts, p1, [k1, p1] 4 times.
Row 2 (WS): K1, [p1, k1] 4 times, work Swirling Pattern to last 9 sts, k1, [p1, k1] 4 times. Cont in est'd patt until piece meas $391 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ from cast-on edge or to desired length minus $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, end having just worked a WS row.

## Edging

Row 1 (RS): P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end. Row 2 (WS): K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end. Rep Rows 1-2, until piece meas 42 " from caston edge, loosely bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends.
