



Herringbone Blanket

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 38"
Length: 42"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Puzzle* (100% Acrylic;
7 oz/200 g, 328 yards/300 m)

- 1050-20 Backgammon – 3 balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) 36" circular needle
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

15 sts x 20 rows = 4" in pattern stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

RLI (Right Lifted Increase): Knit into the right shoulder of the st below the first st on the left-hand needle.

PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is worked flat from end to end, a circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches.

BLANKET

Cast on 144 sts.

Work 6 rows even in Garter st (knit every row).

Main Body

Row 1 (RS): K5, *k2tog, k2, RLI, k3; rep from * to last 5 sts, k5.

WS Rows 2 and 4: K5, purl to last 5 sts, k5.

Row 3: K6, *k2, RLI, k3, k2tog; rep from * to last 5 sts, k5.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

Work even in patt until Blanket meas 41" from cast-on edge, work 6 rows in Garter st (knit every row).

Loosely bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wash and block to finished measurements if desired.

Abbreviations

dec('d) decrease(d)

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

meas measures

patt pattern

rep repeat

RS right side

st(s) stitch(es)

WS wrong side
