

**Pocket Scarf** 

#### SIZE

One Size

## **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 7½" Length: 56"

Pocket depth: 10"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Puzzle® (100% acrylic; 7oz/200g, 328yds/300m)

• 1050-19 Checker – 2 balls

Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook or size

needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

### **GAUGE**

16 sts x 4½ rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and double crochet stitches.
- Front post and back post double crochet stitches.
- Seaming.

#### STITCH GUIDE

**Fpdc (front post double crochet):** Yo, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of the st and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

**Bpdc (back post double crochet):** Yo, insert hook from back to front to back around the post of the st and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Scarf is made in one panel with ends folded up and sewn on sides to create pockets.

#### **SCARF**

Ch 31.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sc in  $2^{nd}$  ch from hk and in each ch across, turn -30 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, \*fpdc around next st, bpdc in next st; rep from \* across, ending with sc in last st. turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, \*bpdc around next st, fpdc in next st; rep from \* across, ending with sc in last st, turn.

Rows 4-5: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Rows 6-7: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, sc in next 2 sts, \*ch 2, sk 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* across, turn.

Row 9: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 4 dc in each ch-2 sp across to last 2 sts, sk 1 st, dc in last st, turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in sp between last st and next st \*ch 2 sk next 4 dc sc between

st and next st, \*ch 2, sk next 4 dc sc between last skipped st and next dc; rep from \* .to last 2 sts, sc between last 2 sts, sc in last st, turn.

Rep Rows 9 and 10 until Scarf is about 73", ending with a Row 10.

#### Last 8 Rows:

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, \*2 sc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* across, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, \*fpdc around next st, bpdc in next st; rep from \* across, ending with sc in last st, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in first st, \*bpdc around next st, fpdc in next st; rep from \* across, ending with sc in last st, turn.

**Rows 5-6:** Rep Rows 3-4.

# project continued

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each st across. Row 8: Ch 1, sl st in each sc across.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

## **Pockets**

Take one end of scarf and fold back 19" on top of scarf (this will create the pocket), making sure the RS is on the outside. Sew each side of pocket. Rep on opposite end of scarf.

## **Abbreviations**

**ch** chain

dc double crochet

**hk** hook

rem remain(ing)rep repeatRS right sidesc single crochet

sk skip
sp(s) space(es)
st(s) stitch(es)
yo yarn over
