

## Radiant Ripple Afghan

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

$49^{\prime \prime} \times 54^{\prime \prime}$

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Puzzle ${ }^{\circledR}$ (100\% Acrylic;
7oz/200g, 328yds/300m)

- 1050-07 Riddle - 6 balls

Hook: US Size J-10 ( 6 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

12 sts $\times 6$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in Ripple Stitch Save time, check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

Ripple Stitch (Multiple of 12 sts +15 )
Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (unworked chains count as dc), dc in next 3 ch, [dc2tog] twice, *dc in next $3 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 2 ch , dc in next 3 ch, [dc2tog] twice, rep from * to last 4 chs, dc in next 3 ch, 2 dc in last ch, turn.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same st, dc in next 3 sts, [dc2tog] twice, *dc in next 3 st, 2 dc in next 2 st, dc in next 3 st, dc2tog twice; rep from * to last 3 sts, dc in next 3 st,
2 dc in top of turning ch.
Rep Row 2 for patt.

## AFGHAN

Ch 147.
Work in Ripple Stitch until piece measures approximately 54".
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

ch chain
dc double crochet
dc2tog double crochet the next 2 sts together (1 st dec)
patt pattern
rep repeat(ing)
st(s) stitch(es)
