

Seismic Knit Throw

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 40" Length: 49"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Parfait® (100% Polyester;

10.5oz/300g 574yds/525m)

#1044-15 Taupe – 2 balls (A)
#1044-13 Cream – 2 balls (B)

Needles: US Size 15 (10 mm) 32" circular knitting needle hook *or size needed to obtain*

gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, scissors, tape

measure

GAUGE

8 sts x 14 rows = 4" in St st with two strands held

together.

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

St st with Border

Row 1 (RS): Knit across.

Row 2 (WS): K6, p to last 6 sts, k6.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

The throw is worked in a double-strand of yarn

throughout.

THROW

With A, Cast on 80 sts. K 6 rows in Garter st.

Work in St st with Border patt now and

throughout.

Work as follows:

26 rows A.

4 rows B.

26 rows A. 10 rows B.

18 rows A.

18 rows A. 18 rows B.

10 rows A.

26 rows B.

4 rows A.

26 rows B.

K 6 rows in Garter st. BO all sts on next row.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

Garter st knit every row

k knit

p purl

patt pattern

rep repeat(ing)

RS right side st(s) stitch(es)

st st stockinette stitch

WS wrong side
