

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

$36^{\prime \prime} \times 36^{\prime \prime}$

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Puzzle ${ }^{\circledR}$ (100\% Acrylic; $7 \mathrm{oz} / 200 \mathrm{~g}, 328$ yards/300 m)

- 1050-36 Trivia - 3 balls

Needle: US Size 10 ( 6 mm ) 36" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

15 sts x 25 rows $=4$ " in Garter stitch
Save time, check your gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is a modular square, made up of four triangles.

## BLANKET

## Triangle One

Cast on 96 sts.

## Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2 (RS): Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog -

## 1 st dec'd.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until 1 st rem, break yarn and pull through rem st.

## Triangle Two

With RS of Triangle One facing (with the cast on edge on the right and the dec edge on the bottom), pick up and knit 96 sts along the top edge.
Row 1 (WS): Knit.
Row 2 (RS): Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog -

## 1 st dec'd.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until 1 st rem, break yarn and pull through rem st.

## Triangle Three

With RS of Triangle Two facing (with the picked-up edge on the right and the dec edge on the bottom), pick up and knit 96 sts along the top edge.
Row 1 (WS): Knit.
Row 2 (RS): Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog 1 st dec'd.
Rep Rows 1 and 2 until 1 st rem, break yarn and pull through rem st.

## Triangle Four

With RS of Triangle Three facing (with the picked-up edge on the right and the dec edge on the bottom), pick up and knit 96 sts along the top edge.
Row 1 (WS): Knit to last st, sl 1 kwise, pick up and k1 from cast on edge of Triangle One, psso. Row 2 (RS): Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog -
1 st dec'd.
Rep Rows 1 and 2 until 1 st rem, break yarn and pull through rem st.

Abbreviations

| dec('d) | decrease(d) |
| :--- | :--- |
| Garter st | Knit every row. |
| k2tog | knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd) |
| kwise | knitwise |
| psso | pass slipped stitch over |
| rem | remain(ing) |
| rep | repeat(ing) |
| RS | right side |
| sl | slip |
| st(s) | stitch(es) |
| WS | wrong side |
