

# **Sutton Throw**

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS** 

Length: 42" Width: 36"

**MATERIALS** 

Premier® Yarns Puzzle® (100% Acrylic; 7oz/200g, 328yds/300m)

1050-28 Jacks – 4 balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) 32" circular needle

or size needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle

**GAUGE** 

15 sts x 17 rows = 4" in Spiral Columns Pattern **Save time, check your gauge.** 

STITCH GUIDE

**Spiral Columns Pattern** (multiple of 8+2 sts) **Rows 1 and 3 (RS):** P2, \*k6, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rows 2 and 4 (WS):** K2, \*p6, k2; rep from \* to end

**Row 5:** P2, \*k2, k2tog, k2, yo, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Row 6:** K2, \*p1 tbl, p5, k2; rep from \* to end. **Row 7:** P2, \*k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Row 8:** K2, \*p1, p1 tbl, p4, k2; rep from \* to end.

**Row 9:** P2, \*k2tog, k2, yo, k2, p2; rep from \* to end

**Row 10:** K2, \*p2, p1 tbl, p3, k2; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rows 1-10 for patt.

## **PATTERN NOTES**

This throw is worked flat from end to end in one piece, a circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches.

#### **THROW**

Cast on 138 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K4, work Spiral Columns Pattern (beg with Row 1) to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 2 (WS): K4, work Spiral Columns Pattern to last 4 sts, k4.

Cont in est'd patt until piece meas 42" from cast-on edge or to desired length, loosely bind off all sts.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in all ends.

### **Abbreviations**

beg begin(ning)cont continuedec('d) decrease(d)est'd established

**k** knit

**k2tog** knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

meas measures
p purl
patt pattern
rep repeat(ing)
RS right side
st(s) stitch(es)

**tbl** through the back loop

ws wrong side yo yarn over
