

Macramé Bracelet

By Premier Yarns Design Team Level: Intermediate



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: %" Length: 8"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Raffia (100% Cellulose Rayon; 35 gm/87 yds)

• #99-09 Red Maple - 1 ball

Notions: Six 10mm wood pony beads, T-pin, pinnable surface

STITCH GUIDE

Square Knot

Step 1: Pass the two left tying strands over the anchor strands and under the right tying strands.

Step 2: Pass the right tying strands under the anchor strands and up through the loop formed by the left tying strands.

Step 3: Pull left and right tying strands to snug up the knot around the anchor strands.

Step 4: Pass the two right tying strands over the anchor strands and under the left tying strands.

Step 5: Pass the left tying strands under the anchor strands and up through the loop formed by the right tying strands.

Step 6: Pull left and right tying strands to snug up the knot around the anchor strands.

Your square knot is complete!

BRACELET

Cut 3 strands of yarn 30" long. Thread all three strands through a bead, and slide the bead to the center of the strands {photo 1}. Hold all strands together to tie an overhand knot, securing the bead in place {photo 2}.

Secure bead to pinnable surface with a T-pin. You'll need the pin to hold fast when you tug on it a bit. Prepare the strands of yarn for knotting. Spread them out in pairs, so there are two strands in the center and two strands on each side. The two center strands are the anchor strands. The outer strands are the tying strands.

Tie 3 square knots. {photo 3}

* Thread the anchor strands through a bead and slide the bead up snug against your knots. Bringing the tying strands down on either side of the bead, tie 3 more square knots. {photo 4} Repeat from * 3 more times. A total of 5 beads have been placed, including the bead at the beginning. Keeping your strands of yarn in pairs, make a braid 2½" long. {photo 5} Thread all 6 strands of yarn through a bead and slide the bead over the braid to your last square knot.

Fold the braid into a loop and tie the ends around the braid in an overhand knot. Trim the ends to form a tassel. {photo 6}

To fasten bracelet, slip the starting bead through the braid loop.
