



## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 44"

**Length:** 48"

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Retro Velvet®** (100% Polyester; 9.8oz/280g, 306yds/280m)

- 1088-19 Lavender – 5 balls

**Hook:** US Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm) crochet hook  
*or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

10 sts x 8 rows = 4" in pattern

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Double crochet stitches
- Post stitches
- Chain stitches

## STITCH GUIDE

**Fpdc (front post double crochet):** Yo, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of the st and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

## THROW

Ch 109

**Row 1:** Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook (first 3 skipped ch count as 1 dc), dc in each rem ch across — 107 dc.

**Row 2 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), dc in next 2 sts, \*Fpdc around next st, dc in next 3 sts; rep from \* across, turn.

**Row 3 (WS):** Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, Fpdc in next st, dc in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last 2 sts, Fpdc in next st, dc in last st, turn.

**Row 5:** Rep Row 3

Rep Rows 2-5 until Throw meas 48", end having just worked a WS row.

## FINISHING

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>dc</b>	double crochet
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>rem</b>	remain(ing)
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
