



Split Shells Throw

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 40"

Length: 48"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Retro Velvet® (100% Polyester; 9.8oz/280g, 306yds/280m)

- 1088-27 Waterfall – 5 balls

Hook: US Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm) crochet hook
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

11 sts x 8 rows = 4" in pattern

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Double crochet stitches
- Single crochet stitches
- Chain stitches

STITCH GUIDE

Shell (Sh): (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in indicated stitch or space.

Split Shells Pattern

(multiple of 6 sts + 1 + 2 for the turning ch)

Row 1 (RS): Sh in 6th ch from hook, (first 3 skipped ch count as dc), sk 2 ch, dc in next ch, *sk 2 ch, Sh in next ch, sk 2 ch, dc in next ch; rep from * across, turn — 18 Sh.

Row 2: (WS): Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), sc in each dc and ch-1 sp across, turn— 109 sc.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), 2 dc in same st, sk next 2 sc, dc in next sc, *sk next 2 sc, Sh in next sc, sk next 2 sc, dc in next sc; rep from * to last 3 sc, sk next 2 sc, 3 dc in last sc, turn.

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Ch 3, *sk next 2 sc, Sh in next sc, sk next 2 sc, dc in next sc; rep from * across, turn. Rep Rows 2-5 for patt.

THROW

Ch 111

Work in **Split Shells Pattern** until Throw meas 48", end having just worked a WS row.

FINISHING

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

dc	double crochet
meas	measures
patt	pattern
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat
RS	right side
sc	single crochet
sp(s)	space(es)
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
