

Ribbed Sweater

By Premier Yarns Design Team Level: Intermediate



SIZES

2 (4, 6, 8, 10)y

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 24½ (26, 27½, 29, 31)" Length: 15 (16½, 18, 19½, 21)"

MATERIALS

Premier Yarns® Ever Soft® (100% acrylic; 85gm/158 yds)

- #70-05 Red (A) 2 (2, 3, 3, 4) balls
- #70-33 Grey (B) 1 (1, 1, 2, 2) balls
- #70-36 White (C) 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) balls

Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*, US Size 5 (3.75mm)

straight needle

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

20 sts x 26 rows = 4" in St st Save time, check your gauge.

Directions:

STITCH GUIDE

1x1 Ribbing (multiple of 2 sts + 1)

Row 1 (RS): * K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2: *P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

SWEATER

Body (make 2)

With B and smaller needles, cast on 61 (65, 69, 73, 77) sts.

Beginning with Row 1, work in 1x1 Ribbing for 8 (10, 10, 10, 10) rows.

Switch to larger needles and St st.

*Work 2 rows in B, work 2 rows in C; rep from * until Body measures 9½ (10½, 11½, 12½, 13½)", ending with a WS row.

Sleeves and Yoke

Switch to A.

Row 1 (RS): Cast on 32 (34, 36, 38, 40) sts, knit across – 93 (99, 105, 111, 117) sts.

Row 2 (WS): Cast on 32 (34, 36, 38, 40) sts, knit across – 125 (133, 141, 149, 157) sts.

Row 3: Sl 1 st knit-wise, knit across.

Rep Row 3, until Sleeve measures 5% (6, 6%, 7, 7%)", ending with a WS row.

Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams leaving a 7 (7, 7%, 7%, 8)" neck opening. Sew sleeve and side seams. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

k knit
p purl
patt pattern
rep repeat(ing)
RS right side
sl slip
st(s) stitch(es)

St st Stockinette stitch: Knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.

WS wrong side
