Finger Knit Cowl

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Ribbon™ (65% Cotton, 35% Polyester; 7oz/200g, 65yds/60m)

• 2084-12 Denim – 1 ball **Notions:** Scissors, tapestry needle

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Make a stylish cowl with nothing more than your hands and our Ribbon™ yarn! No previous knit or crochet experience is required to make this fun project. Use this same technique to make hand-knitted cords for other uses, too!

### COWL Step One

Lay the end of the yarn over your palm as shown.

#### **Step Two**

Bring the working yarn (the end of the yarn coming from the ball) around to the back of your hand, underneath your index finger and over your middle finger.


#### **Steps Three - Four**

Take the yarn over your middle finger, under your ring finger, and then over your pinky finger. Notice that you are alternating over/ under with every other finger.

Take the yarn back under your pinky, over your ring finger, under your middle finger, and finally back over your index finger.

One full circuit has now been made.



#### **Step Five**

Repeat Steps Two through Four to complete a second circuit with the yarn. There are now two loops of yarn on each of your four fingers.




### **Steps Six-Eight**

Take the lowermost loop on your index finger and lift it up and over the top loop. Take the lowermost loop on your middle finger and lift it up and over the top loop. Repeat for ring and pinky fingers.

Snug the loops down on your hand. Repeat Steps Five - Eight to make each row of finger knitting. Make your piece approximately 100" long, or three times the desired finished circumference.



Finishing Binding Off


Lift the remaining loop from your index finger up and over to your middle finger. Lift the lower loop from the middle finger up and over the index finger loop that was just moved - 1 stitch bound-off.

Lift the remaining loop from your middle finger up and over to your ring finger. Lift the lower loop from the middle finger up and over the middle finger loop that was just moved - 1 stitch bound-off.

Repeat with the ring finger to pinky finger loop.

When just the pinky finger loop remains, cut the yarn leaving approximately an 8" tail. Carefully remove the loop from your pinky and pass the tail through the loop to secure.





#### **Finishing Continued**

With the tail, sew the ends together. Wrap the piece three time so there are three loops of the same circumference. Take a separate piece of yarn and wrap it around the three loops over the seam to secure. Cut yarn and weave in end.
