



Log Cabin Blanket

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 37"

Length: 37"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Rodeo™ (85% cotton, 15% polyester; 150g/265yds)

- #1066-13 Natural (A) – 1 ball
- #1066-09 Light Red (B) – 1 ball
- #1066-03 Light Blue (C) – 1 ball
- #1066-08 Medium Red (D) – 1ball
- #1066-02 Medium Blue (E) – 1 ball
- #1066-07 Dark Red (F) – 2 balls
- #1066-01 Dark Blue (G) – 2 balls

Needles: US Size 8 (5mm) knitting needles *or* size needed to obtain gauge

US Size I-9 (5.5mm) crochet hook

Notions: Stitch holders, tapestry needle

GAUGE

17 sts x 32 rows = 4" in Garter stitch

Each Log Cabin Block measures approx. 9¼" square

Save time, check your gauge.

BLANKET

Log Cabin Block – make 16

Section 1: With A, cast on 10 sts.

Knit 20 rows.

Section 2: Change to B. Knit 10 rows. Do not break yarn, place sts on holder.

Section 3: Continuing with B, pick up and knit 15 sts down side of piece – 1 st for each garter stitch ridge.

Knit 9 rows. Place sts on holder. Break yarn.

Section 4: With C, pick up and knit 5 sts along side edge of last color B section, then 10 sts along cast on edge of color A – 15 sts.

Knit 9 rows. Do not break yarn, place sts on holder.

Section 5: Continuing with C, pick up and knit 5 sts along side of last color C section, 10 sts along side of color A, and 5 sts along side of first color B section – 20 sts.

Knit 9 rows. Place sts on holder. Break yarn.

Section 6: With D, pick up and knit 5 sts along side of last color C section, knit color B sts from holder, and pick up and knit 5 sts along side of second color B section – 20 sts.

Knit 9 rows. Do not break yarn, place sts on holder.

Section 7: Continuing with D, pick up and knit 5 sts along side of first color D section, knit color B sts from holder, and pick up and knit 5 sts along side of color C – 25 sts.

Knit 9 rows. Place sts on holder. Break yarn.

Section 8: With E, pick up and knit 5 sts along side of last color D section, knit color C sts from holder, and pick up and knit 5 sts along side of second color C section – 25 sts.

Knit 9 rows. Do not break yarn, place sts on holder.

Section 9: Continuing with E, pick up and knit 5 sts along side of first color E section, knit color C sts from holder, and pick up and knit 5 sts along side of of color D – 30 sts.

Knit 9 rows. Place sts on holder. Break yarn.

Section 10: With F, pick up and knit 5 sts along side of last color E section, knit color D sts from holder, and pick up and knit 5 sts along side of second color D section – 30 sts.

Knit 9 rows. Loosely bind off all sts, do not break yarn.

Section 11: Continuing with F, pick up and knit 5 sts along side of first color F section, knit color D sts from holder, and pick up and knit 5

sts along side of color E – 35 sts.

Knit 9 rows. Loosely bind off all sts. Break yarn.

Section 12: With G, pick up and knit 5 sts along side of last color F section, knit color E sts from holder, and pick up and knit 5 sts along side of color E – 35 sts.

Knit 9 rows. Loosely bind off all sts, do not break yarn.

Section 13: Continuing with G, pick up and knit 5 sts along side of first color G section, knit color E sts from holder, and pick up and knit 5 sts along side of color F – 40 sts.

Knit 9 rows. Loosely bind off all sts. Break yarn.

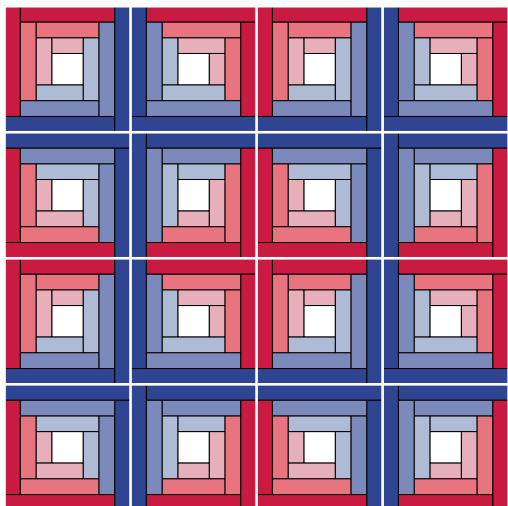
FINISHING

Arrange blocks as shown in diagram. Sew together. With A, work 1 round single crochet around outer edge of blanket.

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.
