



Romeo Throw

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 56"

Width: 42"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Everyday® Soft Worsted (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 113gm/203 yds)

- #100-39 Bright Violet (MC) – 2 balls
- #200-27 Valentine (CC) – 7 balls

Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

1 square = 5½" x 5½" or 7½" diagonally

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The first 6 squares are made individually. After that each square is worked along one edge of 1 or 2 previous squares. No sewing needed! Use the chart to keep track of which square you are working. Color in each square on the chart as your Throw progresses.

THROW

Squares 1-6 (*individual squares, do not connect*)

With MC, ch 30.

Row 1 (WS): Dc in 4th ch from hk, dc in next 10 ch, sk 4 ch, dc in each of next 12 ch, turn – 12 dc each side.

Cut MC, join CC.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc throughout), dc in each of next 9 dc, sk 4 dc, dc in each of next 10 dc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in each of next 7 dc, sk 4 dc, dc in each of next 8 dc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in each of next 5 dc, sk 4 dc, dc in each of next 6 dc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, sk 4 dc, dc in each of next 4 dc, turn.

Row 6: Ch 3, dc in next dc, sk 4 dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, turn.

Row 7: Ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in last dc. Fasten off.

Square 7

With RS facing, join MC to ending st of Square 1. Work 14 sl sts along the edge of Square 1, then work 14 sl sts along the edge of square 2 working toward ending point – 28 sl sts.

Row 1: Ch 3, dc in next 11 sl sts, sk 4 sl sts, dc in next 12 sl sts, turn – 12 dc each side.

Work Rows 2-7 as for Squares 1-6.

Squares 8-11

Work as for Square 7, joining remaining Squares along 1st row.

Square 12

With MC, ch 14, join to top of Square 1, work 14 sl sts along top right edge of Square 7 – 28 sts.

Row 1: Ch 3, dc in next 11 sl sts, sk 2 sl sts, sk 2 ch, dc in next 12 ch, turn – 12 dc each side.

Work Rows 2-7 as for Squares 1-6.

Squares 13-16

Work as for Square 7, working across 2nd row of Squares.

Square 17

With RS facing, join MC to ending st of Square 11, work 14 sl sts across edge of Square 11, ch 16 – 30 sts.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hk, dc in next 10 ch, sk 2 ch, sk 2 sl sts, dc in next 12 sl sts, turn – 12 dc each side.

Work Rows 2-7 as for Squares 1-6.

Work remaining Squares as established, you will have a total of 83 Squares and 15 rows when finished.

Edgings

Edgings are worked in MC to all areas with CC on the edge of the Throw to complete MC outline.

Left Edge

With RS facing, join MC to inside corner of a CC edge. Work 14 sl sts along edge, turn. Ch 3, dc in each sl st across, sl st to edge of next Square. Fasten off. Repeat for all CC edges on Left side of Throw.

Right Edge

With RS facing, join MC to outside corner of a CC edge. Work 14 sl sts along edge, turn, ch 3, sl st to edge of next Square, dc in each sl st across. Fasten off.

Top Edge

With RS facing, join CC to upper right corner. Work 14 sl sts across each top edge of Squares 78-83, turn. Ch 3, *dc in each sl st to point, ch 3, dc in each sl st inside corner, sk last sl st and 1st sl st of next side; rep from & across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
