



Cable Rib Hat

**SIZE**

Adult

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS****Circumference:** 20"**Height:** 10"**MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns *Rustic™* (100% Acrylic;  
7oz/200g, 218yds/200m)

- 2015-19 Olive – 1 ball

**Needles:** US 11 (8mm) 16" circular needle and  
dpns *or size needed to obtain gauge*, US Size 9  
(5.5mm) 16" circular needle

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, cable needle

**GAUGE**

12 sts x 14 rounds = 4" in Cable Patt on larger  
needles, slightly stretched

**Save time, check your gauge.**

**STITCH GUIDE**

**5STRC:** Slip 3 sts onto cable needle and hold to  
back, k2, (p1, k2) from cable needle.

**K2, P1 Rib** (*multiple of 3 sts*)

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, p1; rep from \* around.  
Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

**Cable Pattern** (*multiple of 12 sts*)

**Rnd 1:** \* 5STRC, p1, k2, p1, k2, p1; rep from \*  
around.

**Rnd 2:** \* K2, p1; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 3:** \* K2, p1; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 4:** \* K2, p1, k2, p1, 5STRC, p1; rep from \*  
around.

**Rnd 5:** \* K2, p1; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 6:** \* K2, p1; rep from \* around.

Rep Rnds 1-6 for patt.

**HAT****Brim**

Using smaller needle, cast on 60 sts. Pm and  
join in the round being careful not to twist.  
Work in **K2, P1 Rib** for 1".

Switch to larger needles and work 2 rnds in **K2,  
P1 Rib**.

**Body**

Work in **Cable Patt** for 7½", ending with Rnd 1  
or 4 of patt.

**Shape Crown**

**Rnd 1:** \* Ssk, p1; rep from \* around – 40 sts.

**Rnd 2:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 3:** Ssk around – 20 sts.

**Rnd 4:** Knit.

**Rnd 5:** Ssk around – 10 sts.

**Rnd 6:** Ssk around – 5 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail.

Using tapestry needle, thread yarn through  
remaining stitches and draw closed.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

<b>k</b>	knit
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd</b>	round
<b>ssk</b>	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
