

Courthouse Steps Set

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Pillow

17¼" x 17¼"

Blanket

Length: 69" Width: 56"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Serenity® Chunky (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)

- MC: 700-61 Copper 8 balls
- CC1: 700-62 Flint 5 balls
- CC2: 700-71 Almond 5 balls
- CC3: 700-60 Goldenrod 5 balls
- CC4: 700-73 Clover 5 balls
- CC5: 700-59 Reef 4 balls
- CC6: 700-72 Salmon 4 balls
- CC7: 700-67 Brown Sugar 4 balls

Needles: US Size 10 (6 mm) straight and US Size 10 (6 mm) 40" circular (for Border) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, polyester stuffing

GAUGE

13 sts x 26 rows = 4" in Garter st Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit stitches.
- Picking up and knitting.
- Seaming.

PATTERN NOTES

This set is made up of modular squares that are worked separately and then sewn together. Each square begins in the center. The side sections are worked directly onto previous

sections of each square. The Pillow is made up of two squares that are larger versions of the Blanket squares. See last page for diagrams.

PILLOW (make 2)

Front Piece

Center:

With MC, cast on 14 sts. Knit 28 rows. Bind off all sts.

Note: Colors used for second Pillow are noted in parentheses.

Side 2: With CC4 (CC1), pick up and knit 14 sts along one side of Center 1. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 3: With CC4 (CC1), pick up and knit 14 sts along opposite side of Center 1 as for Side 2. Complete as for Side 2.

Side 4: With CC3 (CC2), pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 3, 14 sts along Center 1, and 7 sts along edge of Side 2 – 28 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 5: With CC3 (CC2), pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 2, 14 sts along Center 1, and 7 sts along edge of Side 3 – 28 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 6: With CC4 (CC1), pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 4, 14 sts along Side 2, and 7 sts along edge of Side 5 – 28 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 7: With CC4 (CC1), pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 5, 14 sts along Side 3, and 7 sts along edge of Side 4 - 28 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 8: With CC3 (CC2), pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 7, 28 sts along Side 4, and 7 sts along edge of Side 6 – 42 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 9: With CC3 (CC2), pick up and knit 7 sts

along edge of Side 6, 28 sts along Side 5, and 7 sts along edge of Side 7 – 42 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 10: With CC4 (CC1), pick up and knit, 7 sts along edge of Side 8, 28 sts along Side 6, and 7 sts along edge of Side 9 – 42 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 11: With CC4 (CC1), pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 9, 28 sts along Side 7, and 7 sts along edge of Side 8 – 42 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 12: With CC3 (CC2), pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 11, 42 sts along Side 8, and 7 sts along edge of Side 10 – 56 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 13: With CC3 (CC2), pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 10, 42 sts along Side 9, and 7 sts along edge of Side 11 – 56 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Back Piece

Work as for Front.

FINISHING

Sew together 3½ sides of pillow using mattress stitch. Stuff with polyester stuffing. Sew together remaining ½ edge. Weave in ends.

BLANKET

Square (make 20)

Note: Using Blanket Diagram as a guide, change colors on Sides as shown.

Center:

With MC, cast on 14 sts. Knit 28 rows. Bind off all sts. **Side 2:** With CC, pick up and knit 14 sts along one side of Center 1. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 3: With CC, pick up and knit 14 sts along opposite side of Center 1 as for Side 2. Comp as for Side 2.

Side 4: With CC, pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 3, 14 sts along Center 1, and 7 sts along edge of Side 2 – 28 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 5: With CC, pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 2, 14 sts along Center 1, and 7 sts along edge of Side 3 – 28 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 6: With CC, pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 4, 14 sts along Side 2, and 7 sts along edge of Side 5 – 28 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 7: With CC, pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 5, 14 sts along Side 3, and 7 sts along edge of Side 4 – 28 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 8: With CC, pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 7, 28 sts along Side 4, and 7 sts along edge of Side 6 – 42 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

Side 9: With CC, pick up and knit 7 sts along edge of Side 6, 28 sts along Side 5, and 7 sts along edge of Side 7 – 42 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts. Sew squares using Blanket Diagram as a guide for placement.

Border

With MC and circular needle, working along short edge of throw, pick up and knit 42 sts evenly along each square – 168 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts. With MC, turn Blanket 90 degrees. Pick up and knit 7 sts along short edge of border just worked, then pick up and knit 42 sts along evenly along each square – 217 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

With MC, turn Blanket 90 degrees. Pick up and knit 7 sts along short edge of border just worked, then pick up and knit 42 sts along evenly along each square – 175 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

With MC, turn Blanket 90 degrees. Pick up and knit 7

sts along short edge of border just worked, then pick up and knit 42 sts evenly along each square, then pick up and knit 7 sts along short edge of first border edge – 224 sts. Knit 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.

Garter st Knit every row.
MC main color


