COWL

First Section Ch 30. Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 2nd ch from hk and in each ch across, turn – 29 hdc. Row 2: Ch 1, working in blo, sc in each st across, turn. Row 3: Ch 1, hdc in each st across, turn. Rows 4-35: Rep Rows 2-3. Do not fasten off.

Second Section **Row 1:** Ch 1, working across ends of rows as sts, hdc in next 35 sts, turn – 35 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, working in the blo, hdc in each st across, turn. Row 3: Ch 1, hdc in each st across, turn. Rows 4-35: Rep Rows 2-3. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Sew ends of pieces together to make a ring. Weave in ends.

HEADWRAP

Ch 48. **Row 1:** Hdc in 2nd ch from hk and in each ch across, turn. **Row 2 (RS):** Ch 1, working in blo, sc in each st across, turn. **Row 3:** Ch 1, hdc in each st across, turn. **Rows 4-11:** Rep Rows 2-3. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Sew ends of pieces together to make a ring. Weave in ends.
