



Draped Vest

Level: Easy

SIZES

Women's S/M (M/L)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 18 (20)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Serenity® Marl (100% acrylic; 270 gm/295 yds)

- #1067-01 Zebra – 2 (3) balls

Needle: Size 11 (8 mm) knitting needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Stitch holder, tapestry needle

GAUGE

12 sts x 18 rows = 4" in Box Stitch
Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN STITCH

Box Stitch (multiple of 4 sts)

Rows 1 (WS) and 2 (RS): * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rows 3 and 4: * P2, k2; rep from * to end.
Rep Rows 1-4 for pattern.

PATTERN NOTE

This vest is worked sideways. It starts at the right front edge and is knit in one piece around the back to the left front edge. The only seams are at the shoulders.

VEST

Cast on 72 (80) sts.

Work in Box Stitch pattern until piece measures 15 (17)", ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulder

Work 20 sts in Box Stitch and put these sts on holder, work in pattern to end – 52 (60) sts.
Work 13 (17) more rows in pattern.

Shape armhole

Next row (RS): Bind off 24 (28) sts, work in pattern to end – 28 (32) sts.
Work 2 rows in pattern.

Next row (WS): Work in pattern to bound off sts, cast on 24 (28) sts – 52 (60) sts.
Work 13 (17) more rows in pattern.

Next row (WS): Work in pattern to end, then work 20 sts from holder in pattern – 72 (80) sts.
Work in pattern until piece measures 29 (33)", ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulder

Work 20 sts in Box Stitch and put these sts on holder, work in pattern to end – 52 (60) sts.
Work 13 (17) more rows in pattern.

Shape armhole

Next row (RS): Bind off 24 (28) sts, work in pattern to end – 28 (32) sts.

Work 2 rows in pattern.

Next row (WS): Work in pattern to bound off sts, cast on 24 (28) sts – 52 (60) sts.

Work 13 (17) more rows in pattern.

Next row (WS): Work in pattern to end, then work 20 sts from holder in pattern – 72 (80) sts.

Work in pattern until piece measures 51 (59)”, ending with a WS row.

Bind off in pattern.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Weave in ends.

Block to finished measurements.

Abbreviations

k	knit
p	purl
RS	Right Side
rep	repeat
st(s)	stitches
WS	Wrong Side
