

Seward Shawl

SIZE

One

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

60" x 36" at the widest

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns D.I.Y. Gradient Yarn (100% Antpilling Acrylic; 40g; 200g/360 yds Total)

• #1046-07 Sunset – 2 sets

Darkest color (A)

Second darkest color (B)

Middle color (C)

Second lightest color (D)

Lightest color (E)

Hook: US Size J-10 (6.0 mm) crochet hook or size

needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

15 sts x 9 rows = 4"

Gauge is worked alternating sc rows by dc rows worked in flo.

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

To change color work to the last step of the stitch before the color change. Complete the stitch with the new color.

STRIPE PATTERN

(2 rows in color A, 2 colors in color B) 12 times, (2 rows in color C, 2 rows in color B) 4 times, (2 rows in color C, 2 rows in color D) 4 times, (2 rows in color E, 2 rows in color D) 2 times, 2 rows in color E.

SHAWL

With color A ch 2.

Row 1 (WS): 2 sc in second ch from hook -2 sc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as a dc here and throughout), turn, working in flo 2 dc in the last st - 3 dc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, working in the flo 2 sc in the 1st st, sc in the next, sc in the 3rd ch of the turning ch - 4 sc.

Row 4: Ch 3, turn, working in the flo, skip the next st, 2 dc in last 2 sts - 5 dc.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, working in the flo 2 sc in the 1st 2 sts, sc in the next, skip 1 st, sc in the 3rd ch of the turning ch – 6 sc.

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, skip the next st, working in the flo, dc in each sts until 3 sts remain, 2 dc in last 3 sts – 8 dc.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, working in the flo 2 sc in the 1st 2 sts, sc in each st until 2 sts remain, skip 1 st, sc in the 3rd ch of the turning ch - 9 sc.

Repeat rows 6 and 7 following the stripe pattern. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block gently.
