

# Simple Chevron Throw

By Premier Yarns Design Team Level: Intermediate



#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 45" Length: 40"

## **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll (100% Acrylic; 140gm/245 yds)

• #1047-08 Mint Swirl - 6 balls

**Needles:** US Size 9 (5.5mm) knitting needles *or size* 

needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch marker

#### GAUGE

16 sts x 30 rows = 4" in Garter stitch Save time, check your gauge.

## **PATTERN NOTES**

The throw is knit in 3 panels, which are sewn together.

It can be challenging to identify the Right Side of your work in Garter Stitch. Use a removable stitch marker to indicate the Right Side.

## **THROW**

Panel (make 3)

Cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 and all WS rows: Knit.

Row 2 (RS): Kfb, knit 1, kfb - 5 sts. Place removable stitch marker on work to indicate RS.

Row 4 (RS): Kfb, knit to last st, kfb - 2 sts increased.

Repeat the last 2 rows, increasing at the beginning and end of every RS row, until there are 75 sts, ending with a WS row.

Next row (RS): Kfb, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Repeat the last 2 rows, increasing at the beginning of every RS row and decreasing at the end of every RS row, until piece measures 45" from cast-on edge, measuring along increase edge, and ending with a WS row.

Next row (RS): K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 2 sts decreased.

Repeat the last 2 rows, decreasing at the beginning and end of every RS row, until there are 3 sts, ending with a WS row.

Bind off.

# **FINISHING**

Arrange panels so diagonal stripes form a chevron design as shown in photo. Sew together. Weave in ends. Block gently.

# **Abbreviations**

**k** knit

k2tog knit 2 stitches together

kfb knit in front and back of same stitch

RS Right Side st(s) stitch(es) WS Wrong Side
