



## Diagonal Knit Blanket

Level: Easy

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

36" x 36"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Snow Cone™ Light Chenille**  
(100% Polyester; 7 oz/200 g, 188 yds/172 m)

- 2013-05 Cool Blue – 3 balls

**Needle:** US Size 10½ (6.5 mm) 24" or longer circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

8 sts x 18 rows = 4" in Garter st

**Save time; check your gauge.**

### PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is worked flat from corner to corner, first increasing and then decreasing to form the square shape. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches. Shown with Esther Bunny.

### BLANKET

Cast on 4 sts.

**Next Row:** Knit.

**Inc Row:** K2, yo, knit to end – 1 st inc'd.

Rep Inc Row 117 more times – 122 sts.

**Dec Row:** K1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, knit to end – 1 st dec'd.

Rep Dec Row 117 more times – 4 sts rem.

Bind off all sts.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

### Abbreviations

<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>Garter st</b>	Knit every row
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>yo</b>	yarn over
