PREMIER

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS 36" x 36"

MATERIALS

Premier[®] Yarns Snow Cone[™] Light Chenille (100% Polyester; 7 oz/200 g, 188 yds/172 m)

 2013-05 Cool Blue – 3 balls **Needle:** US Size 10½ (6.5 mm) 24" or longer circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle

GAUGE

8 sts x 18 rows = 4'' in Garter st Save time; check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is worked flat from corner to corner, first increasing and then decreasing to form the square shape. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches. Shown with Esther Bunny.

BLANKET

Cast on 4 sts. Next Row: Knit.

Inc Row: K2, yo, knit to end – 1 st inc'd. Rep Inc Row 117 more times – 122 sts.

Dec Row: K1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, knit to end -1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row 117 more times – 4 sts rem.

Bind off all sts.

FINISHING Weave in ends.
